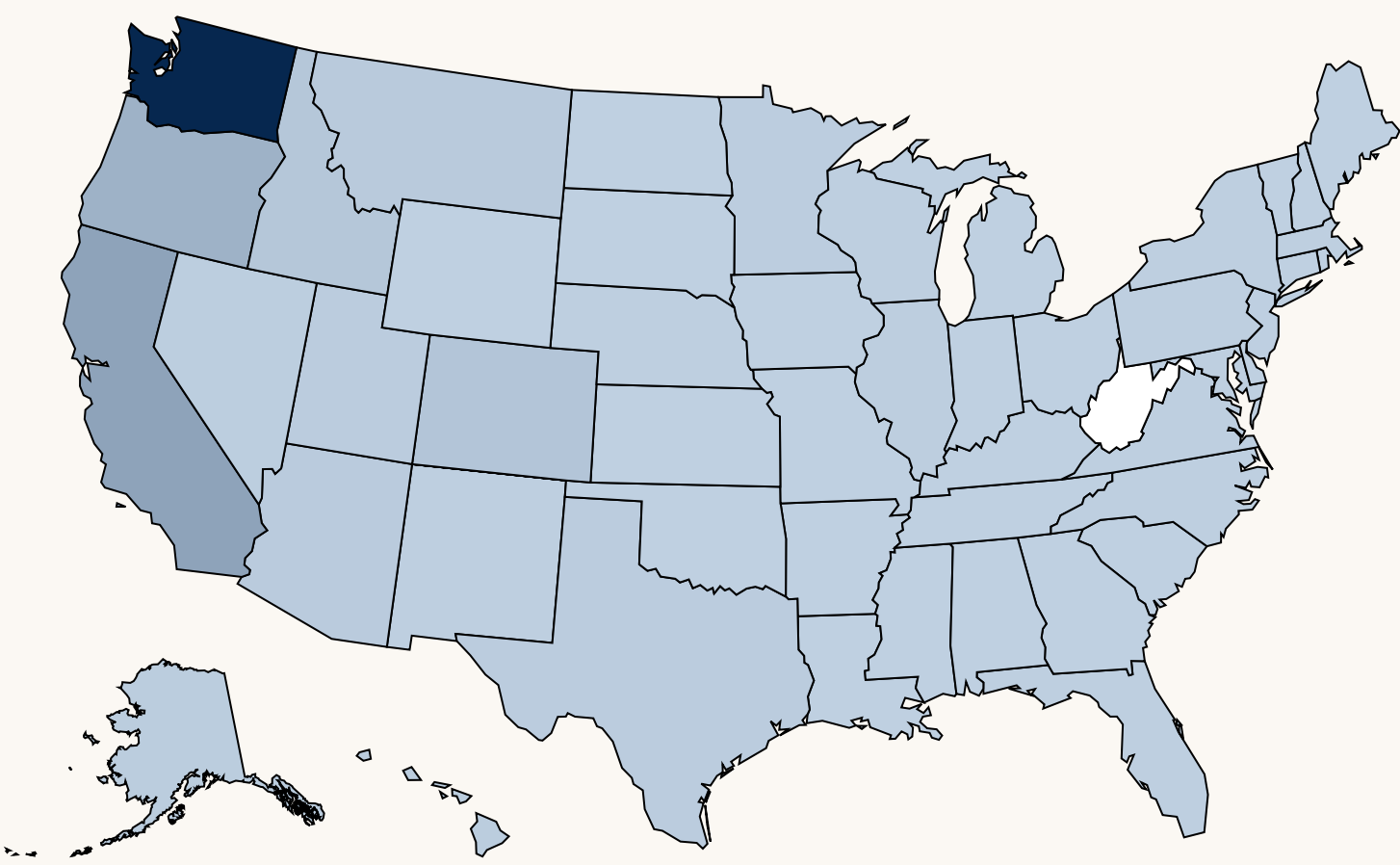

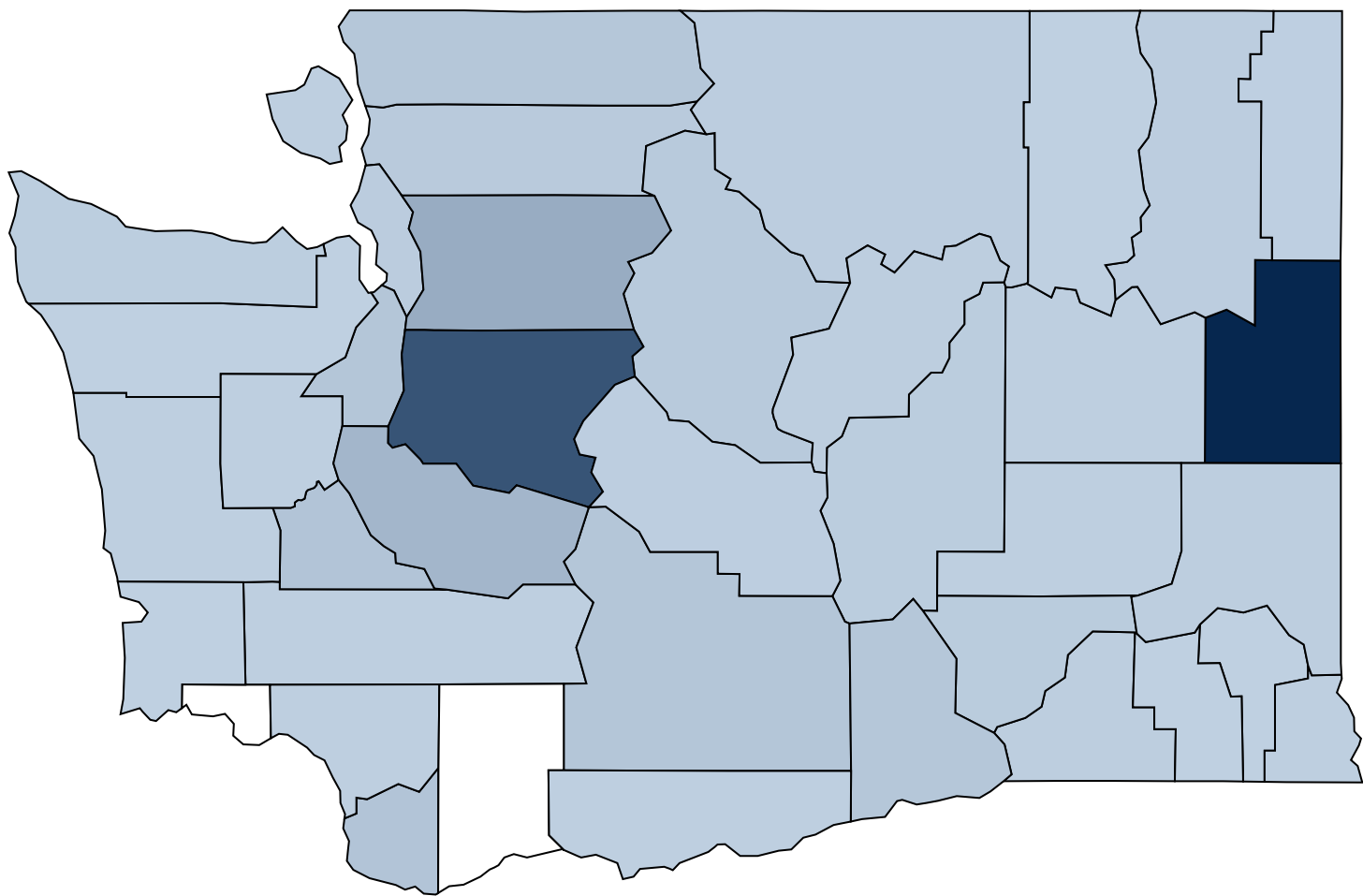

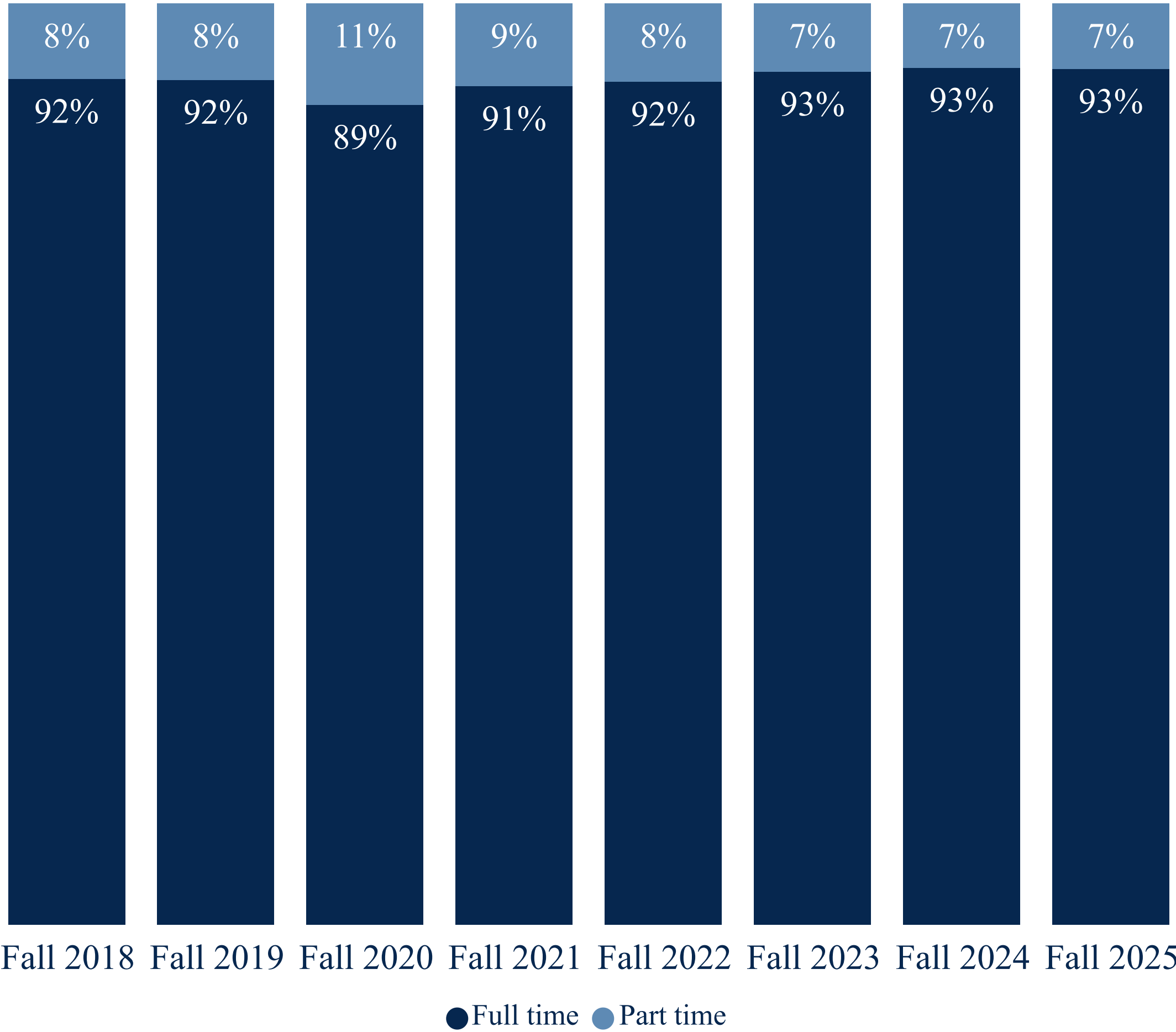

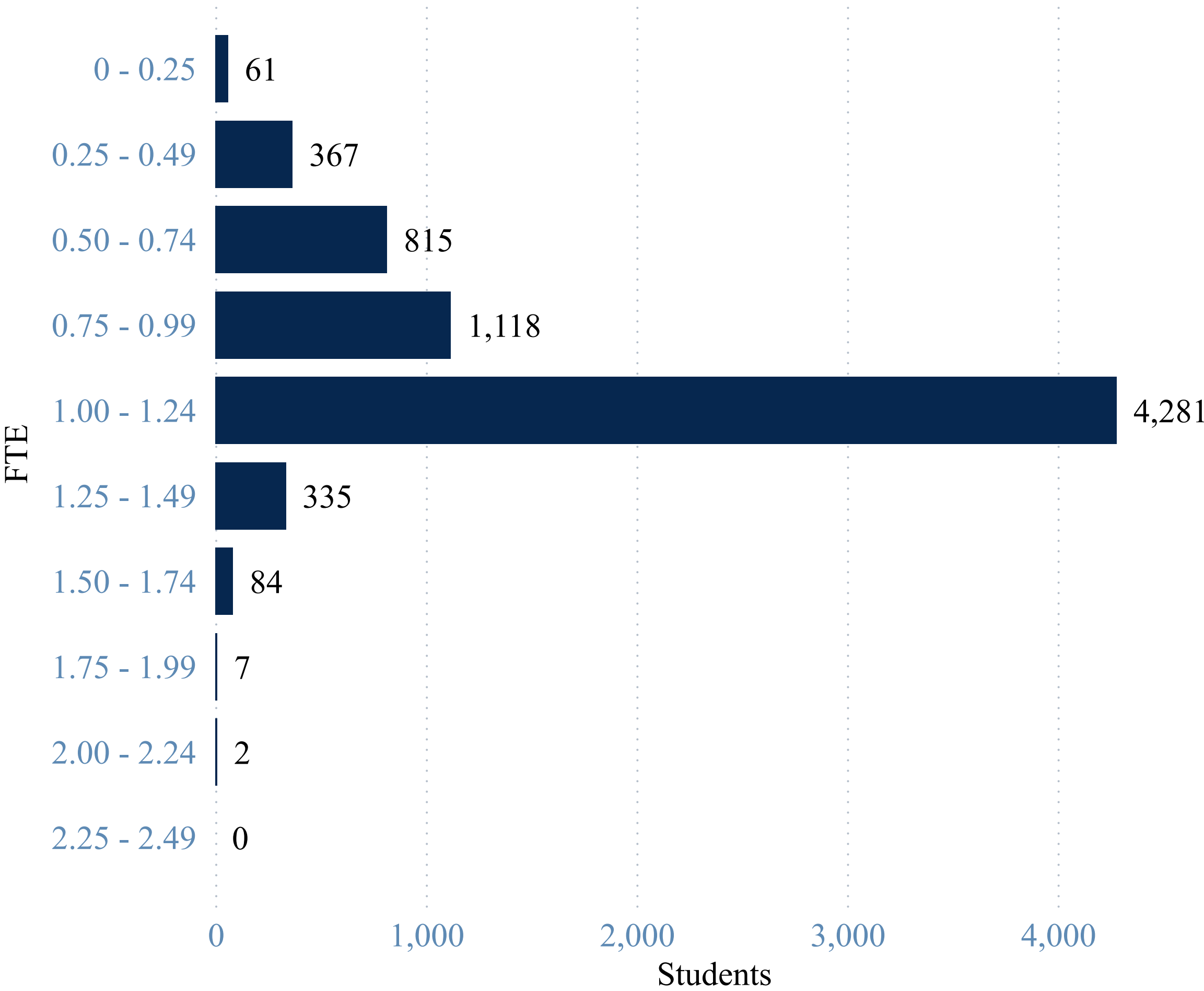

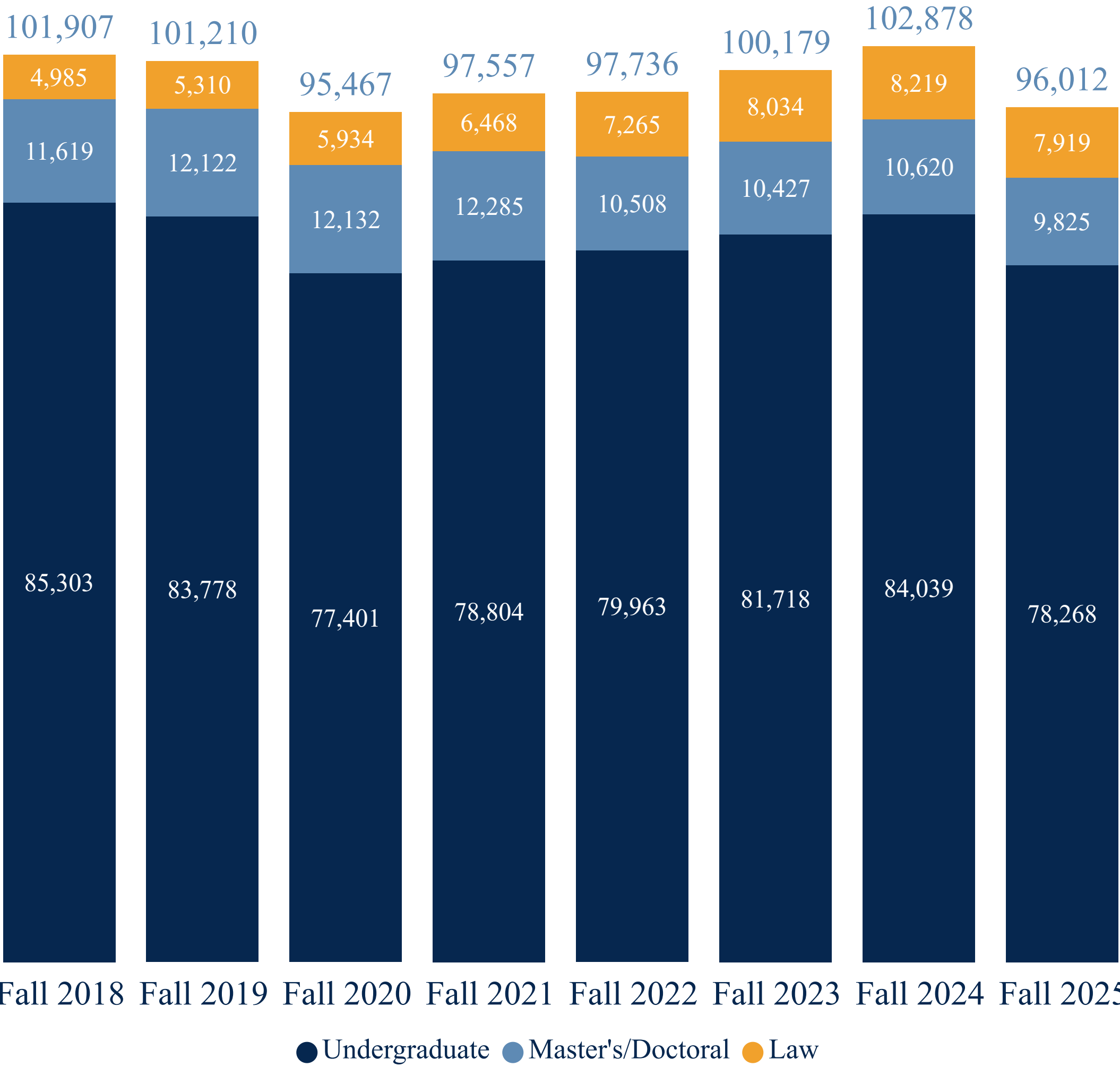
Headcount by Time Status

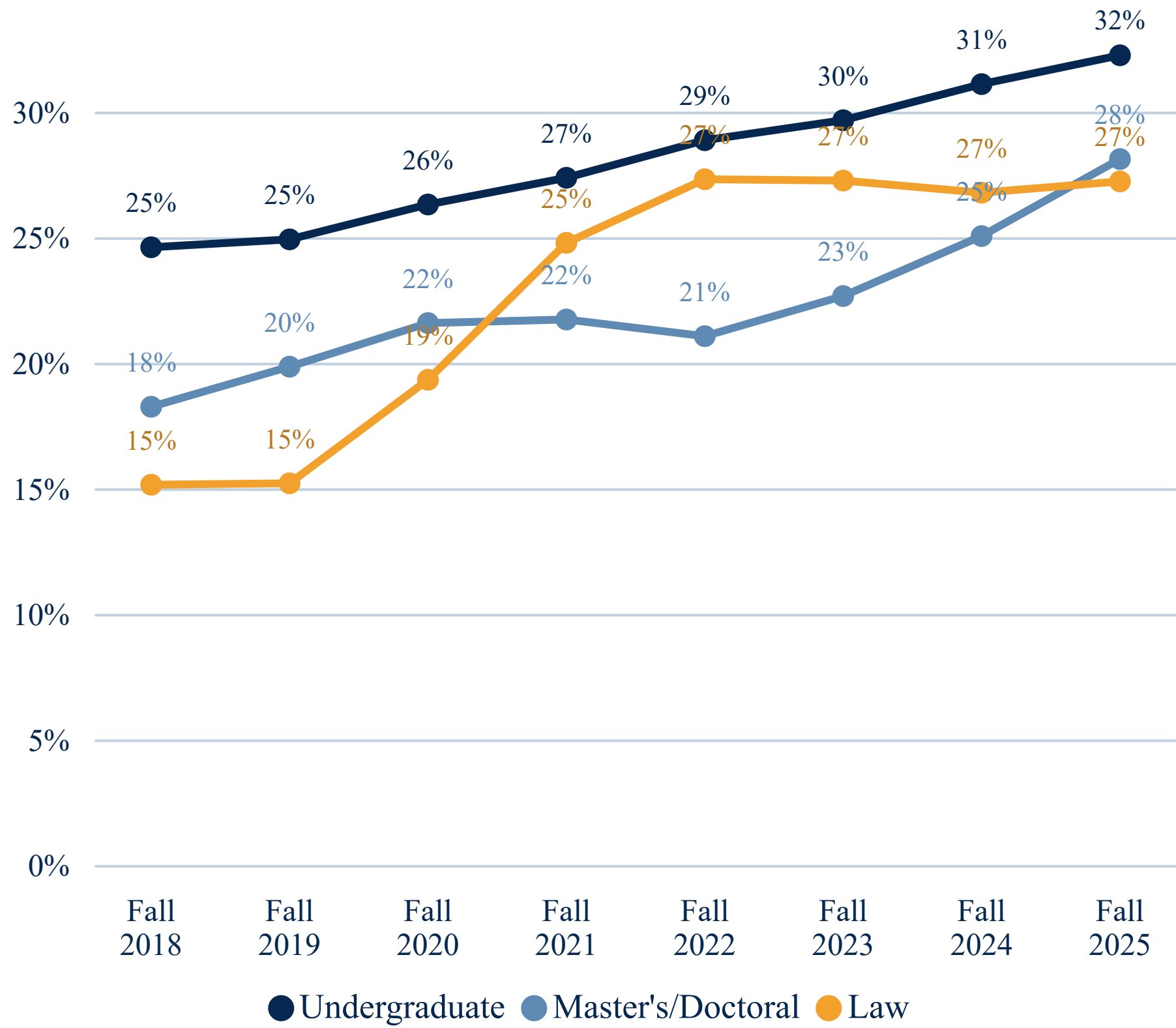

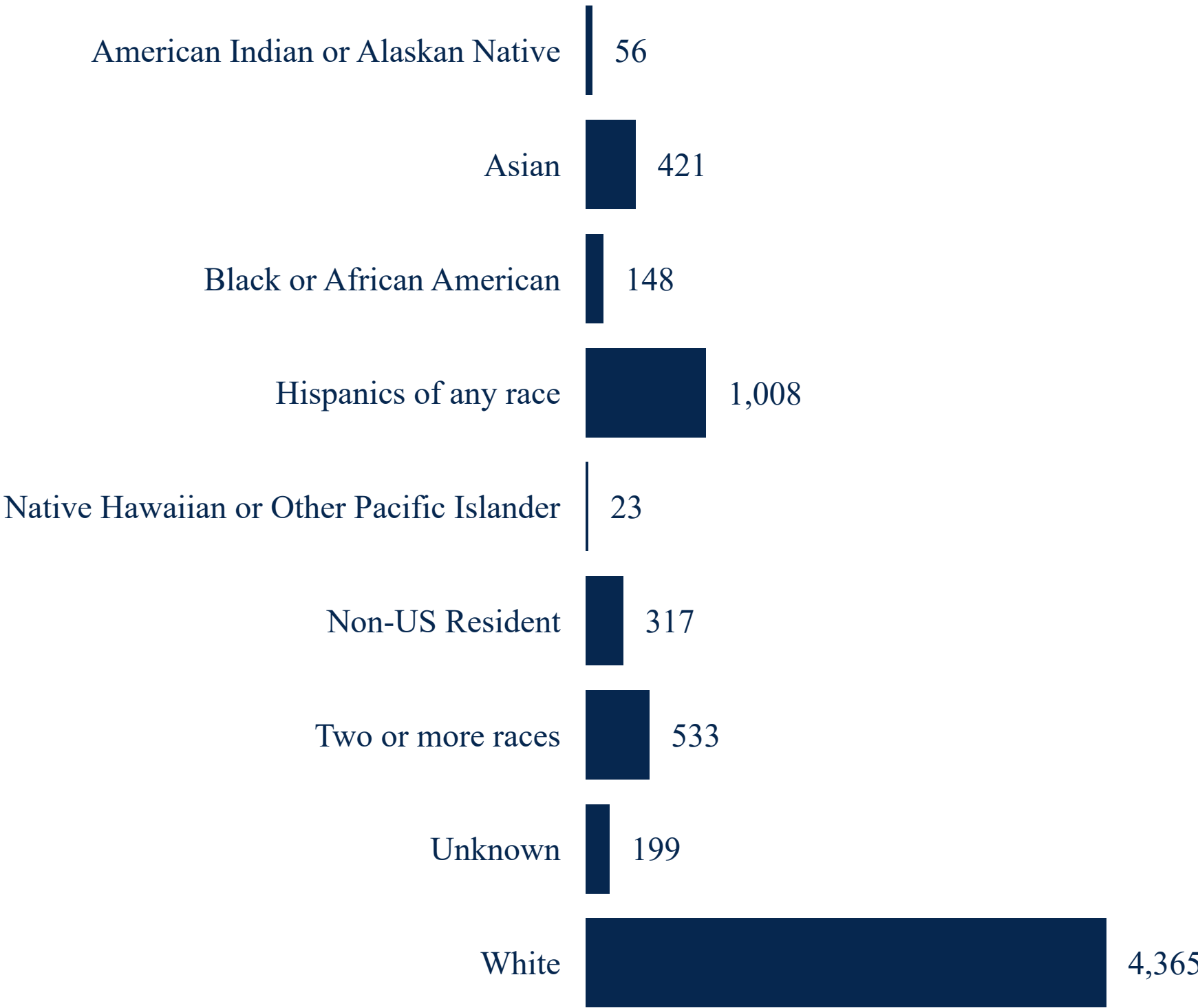

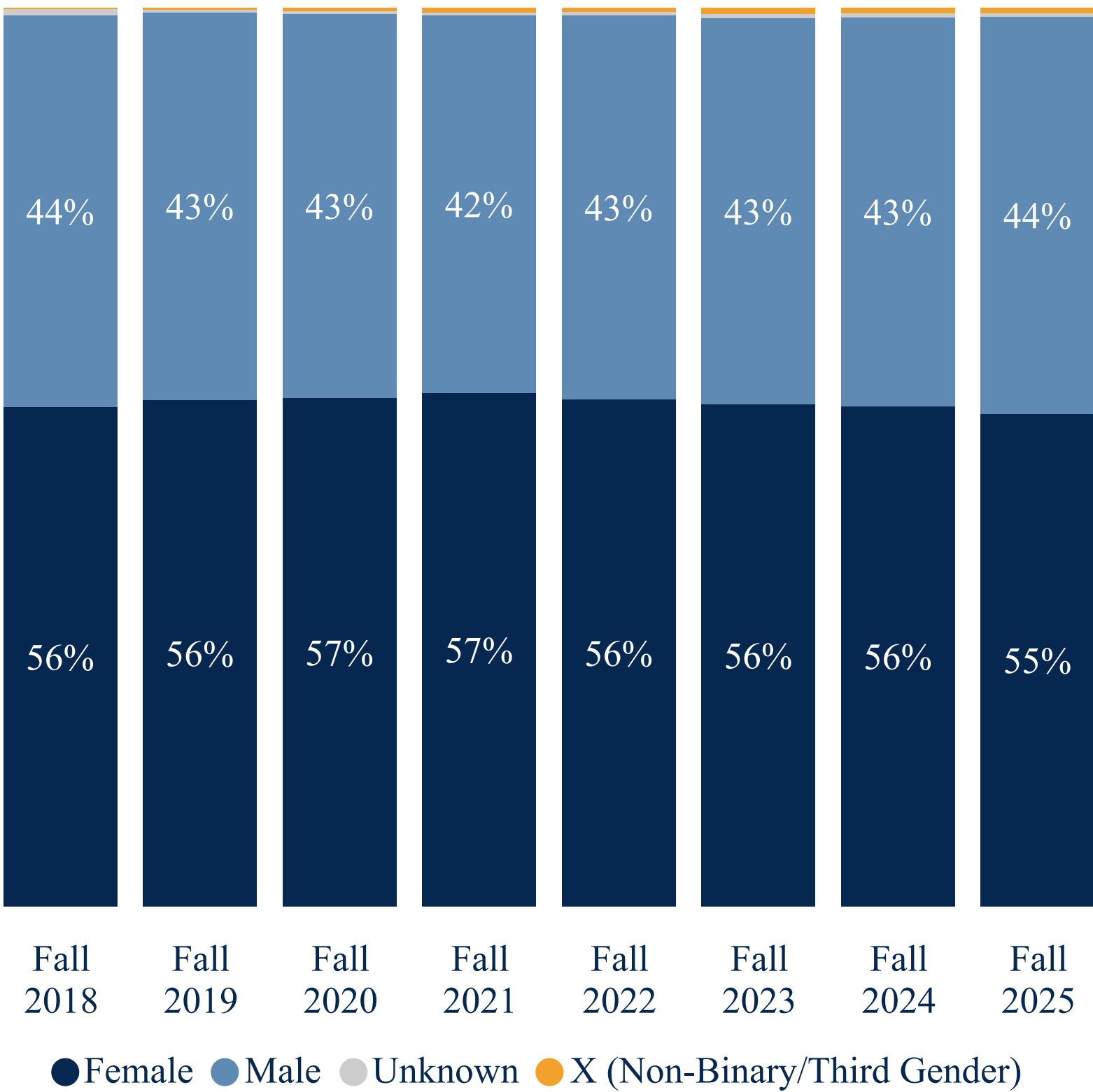

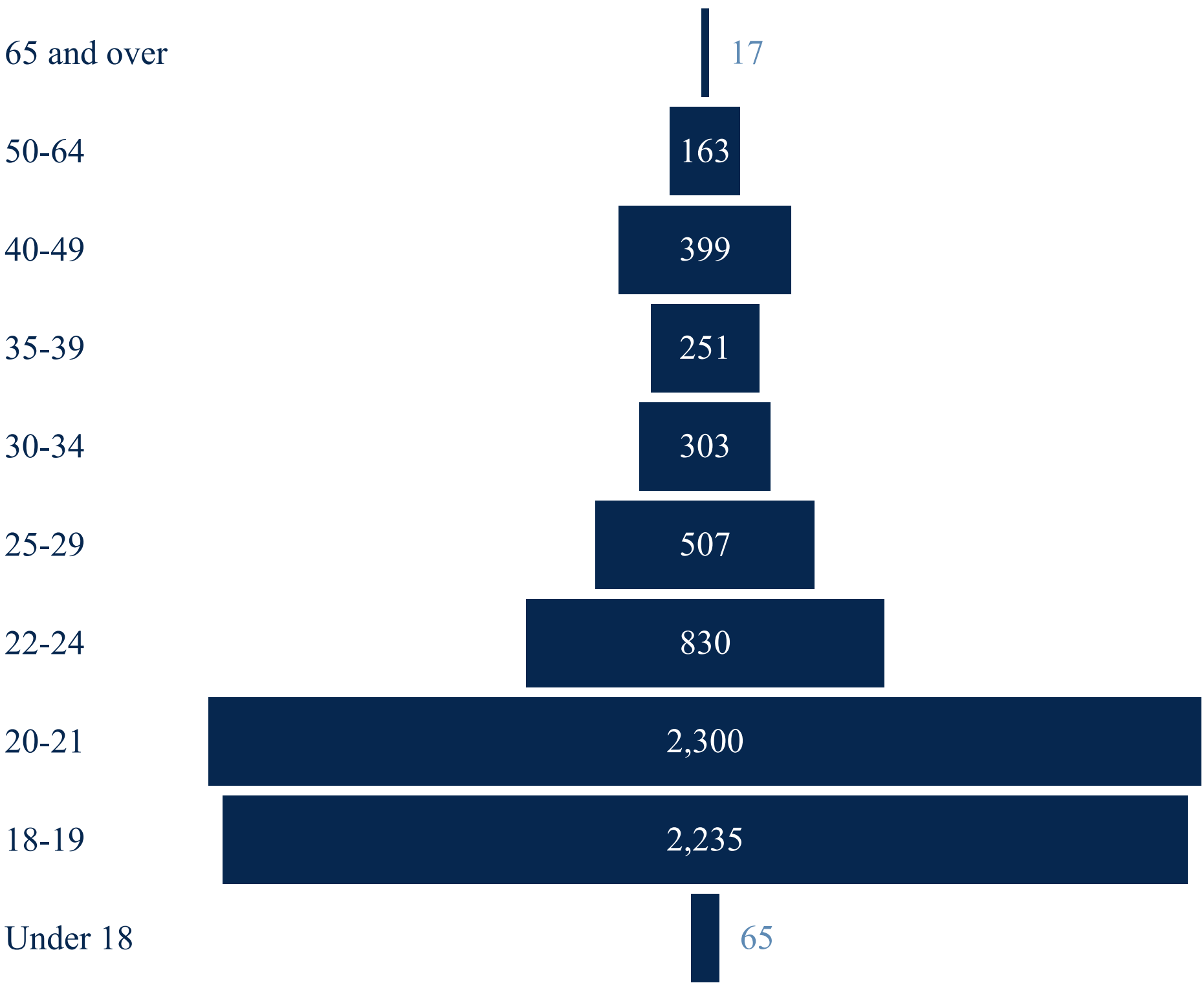

Percentage by Level, Fall 2018 - 2025

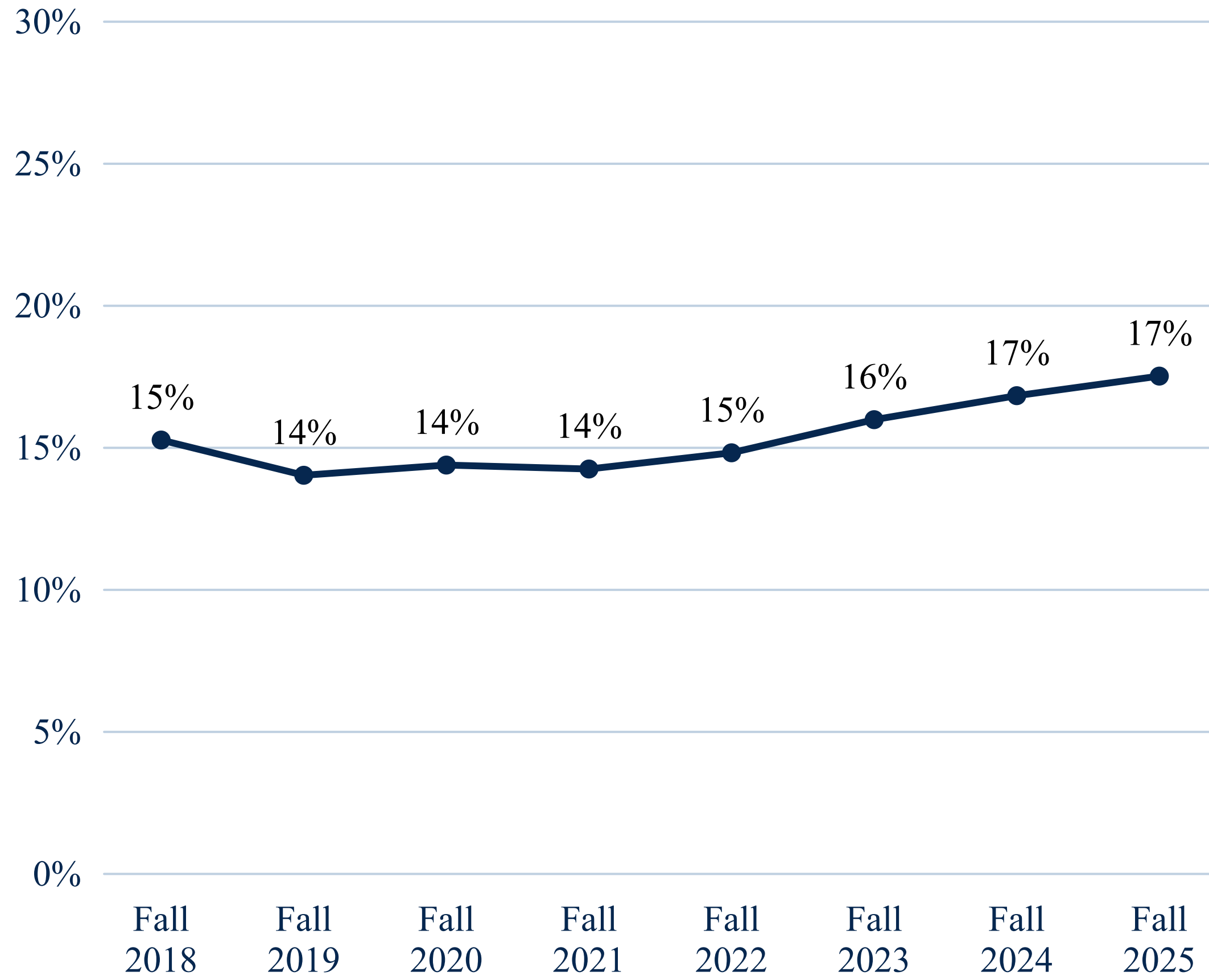


Student Age
Distribution by Level, Fall 2025

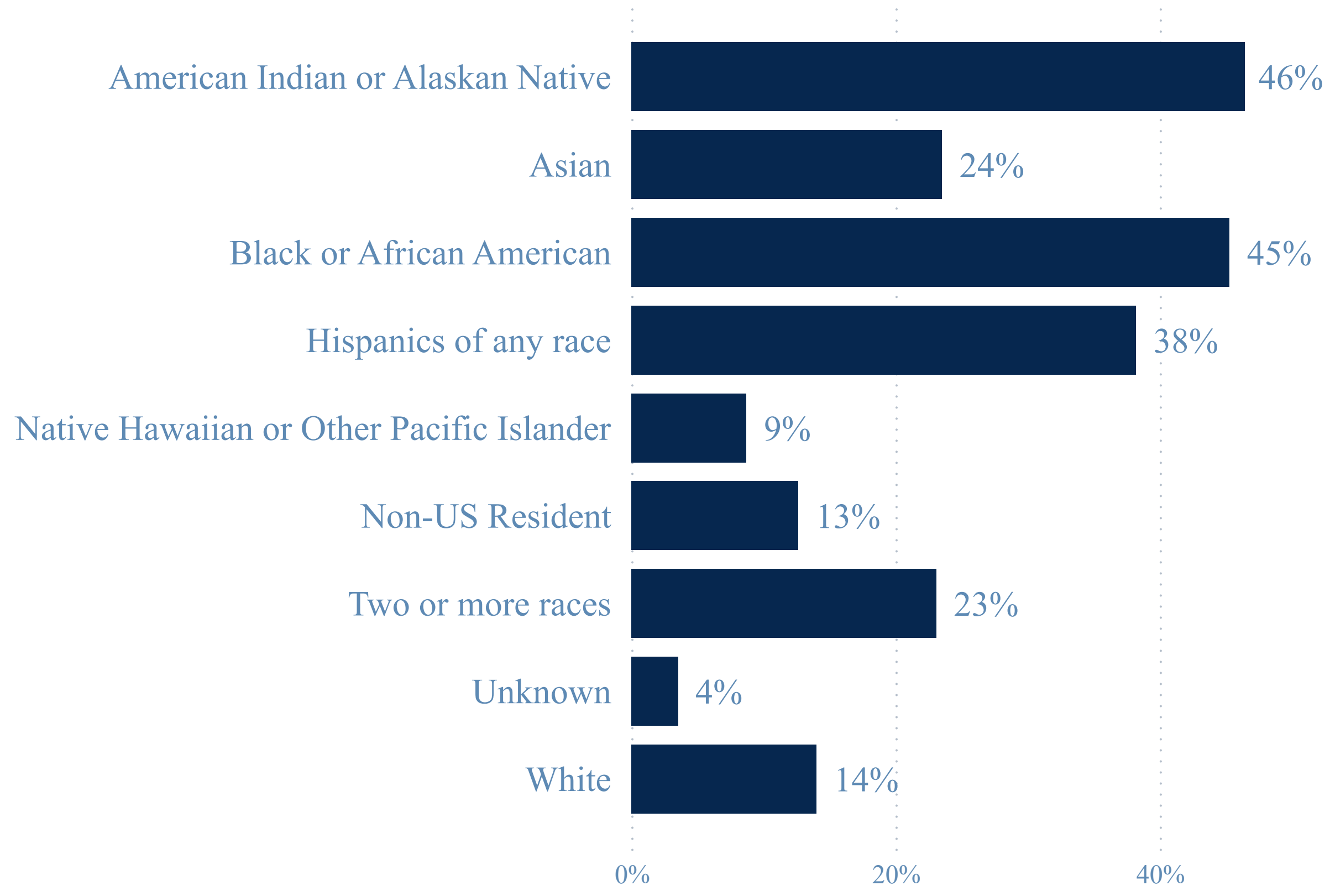


Headcount by First Generation Status

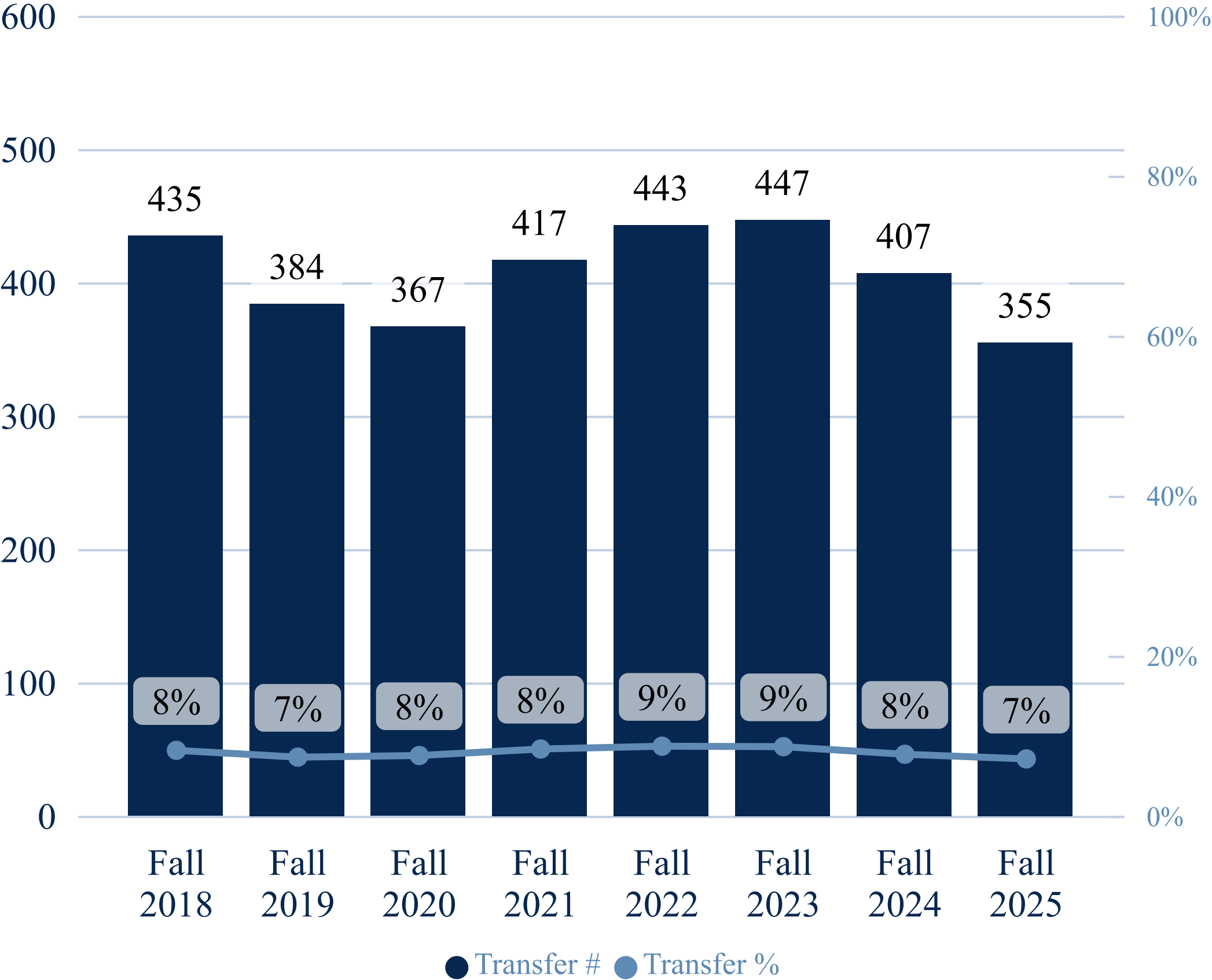
First Generation Students
Percentage of Undergraduates, Fall 2018 - 2025



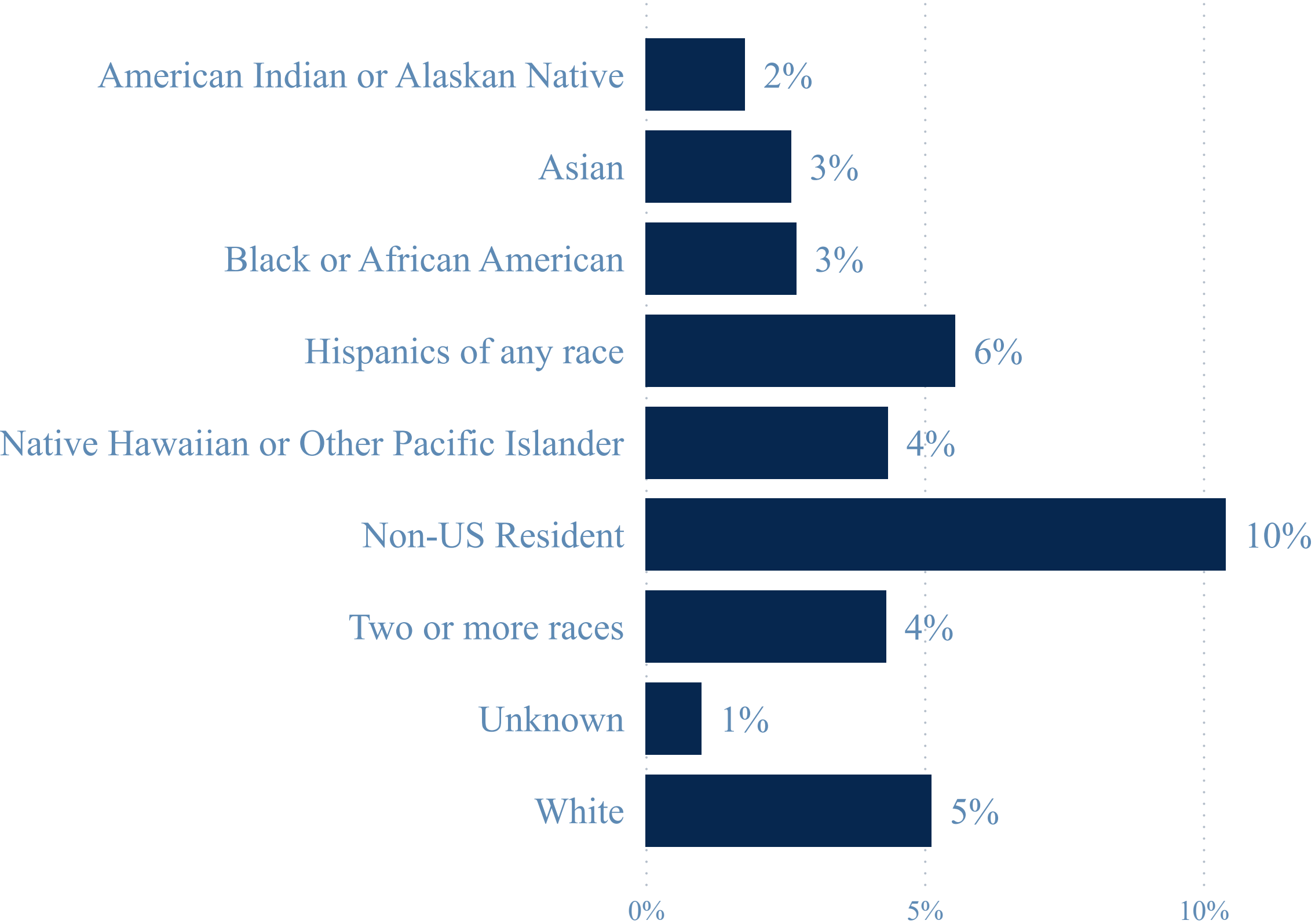
First Generation Students as Percentage of

Undergraduates, Fall 2025



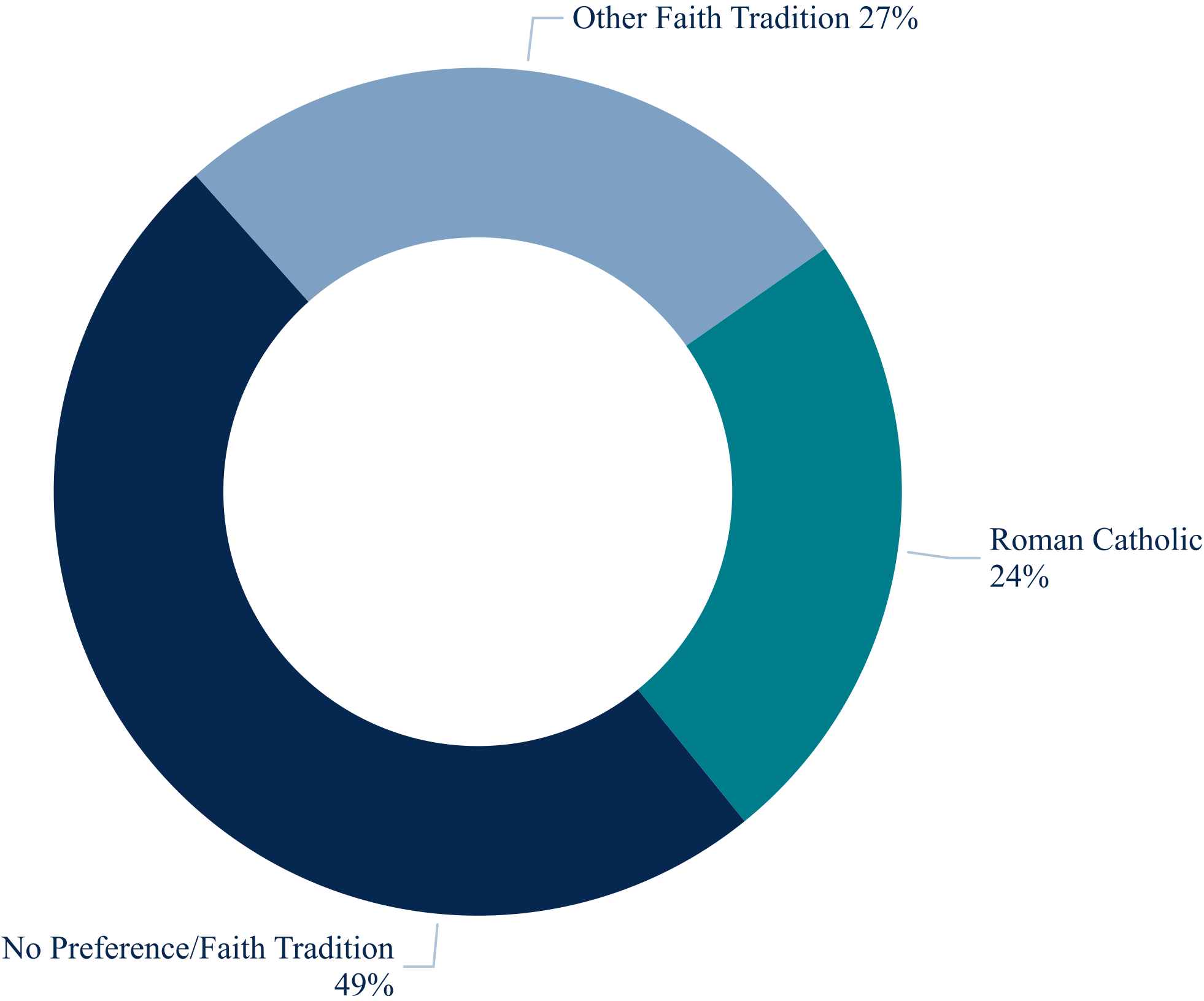
Transfer Students

Undergraduates, Fall 2025



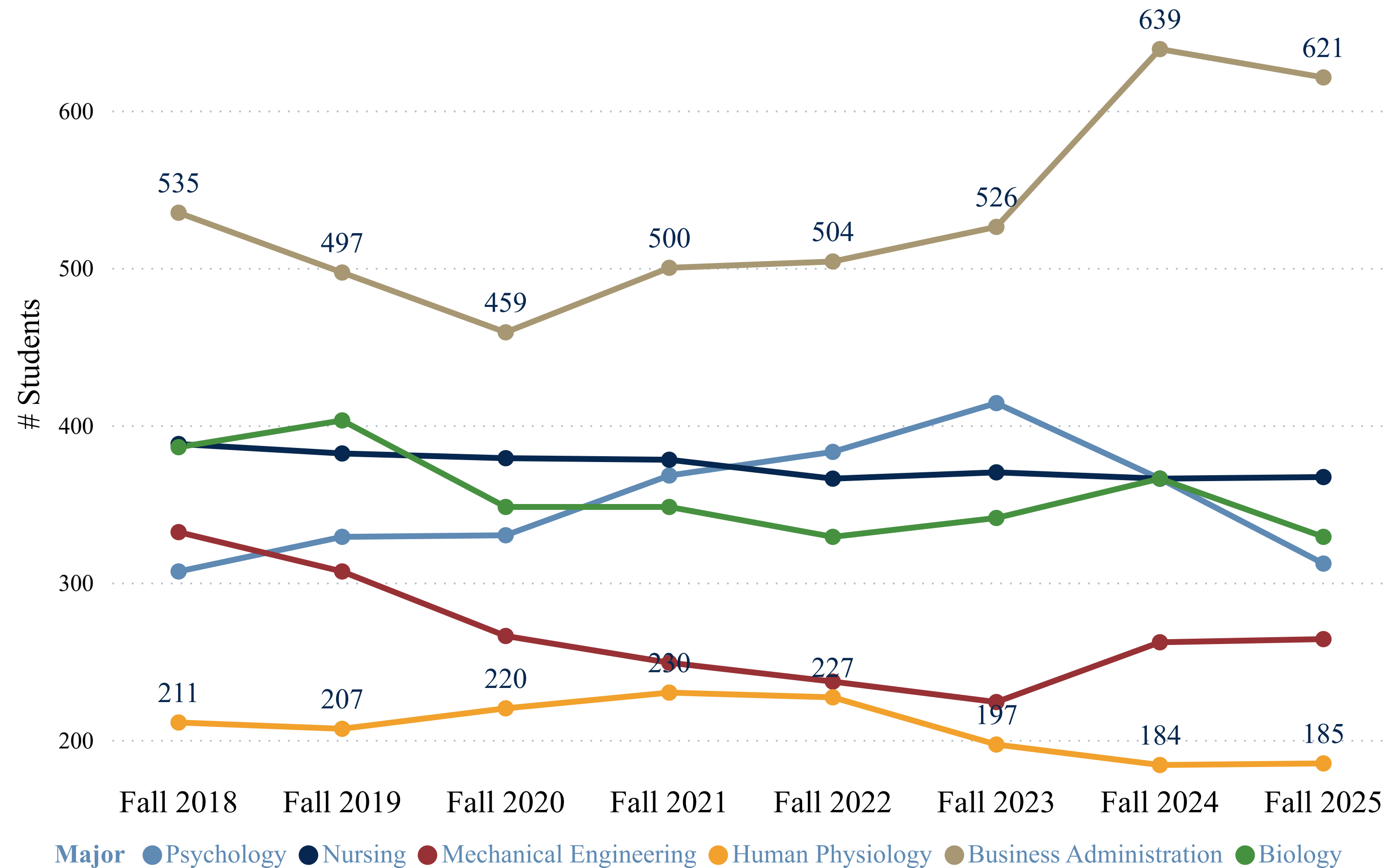
Religious/Faith Traditions Undergraduates, Fall 2025

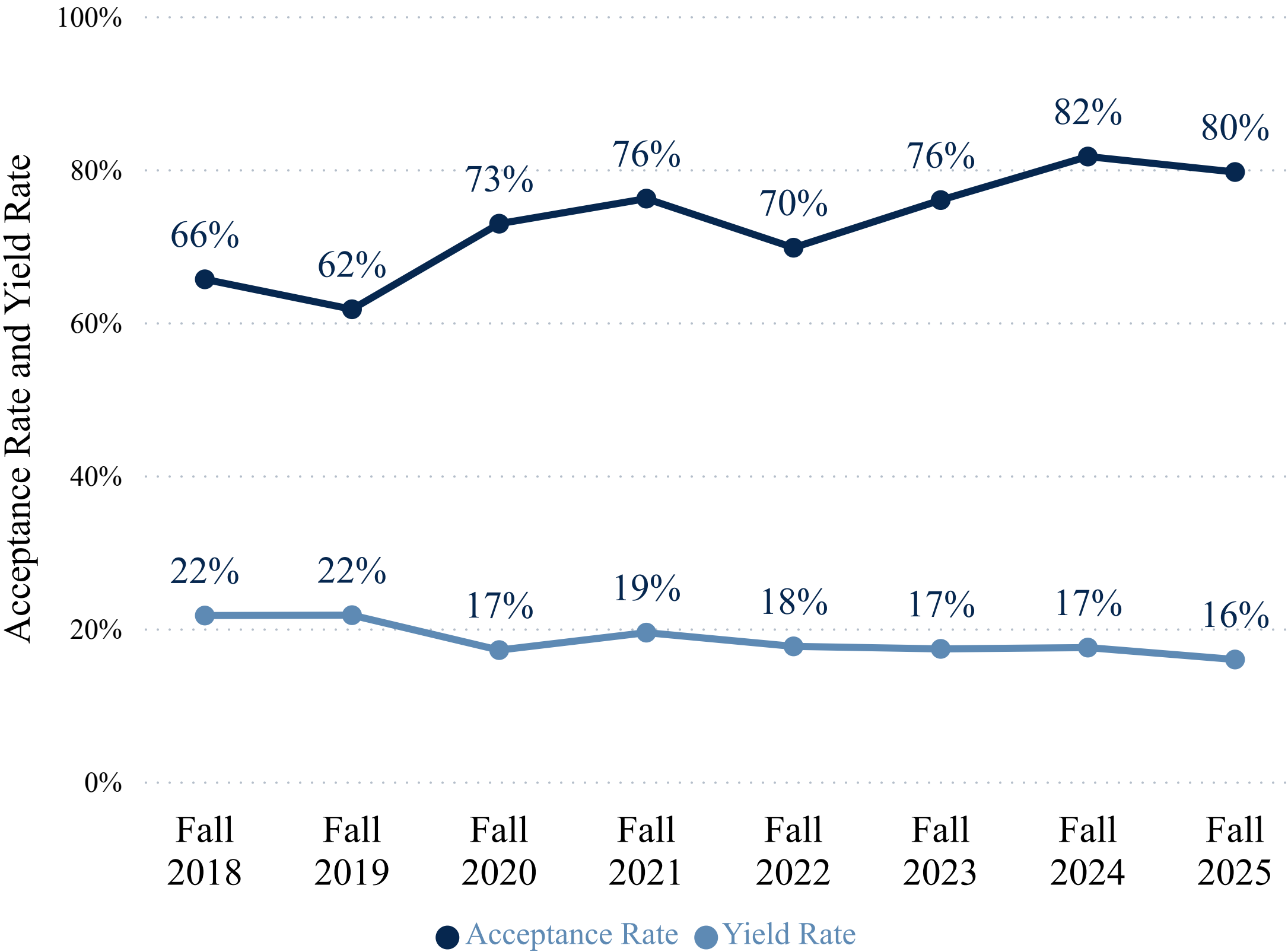

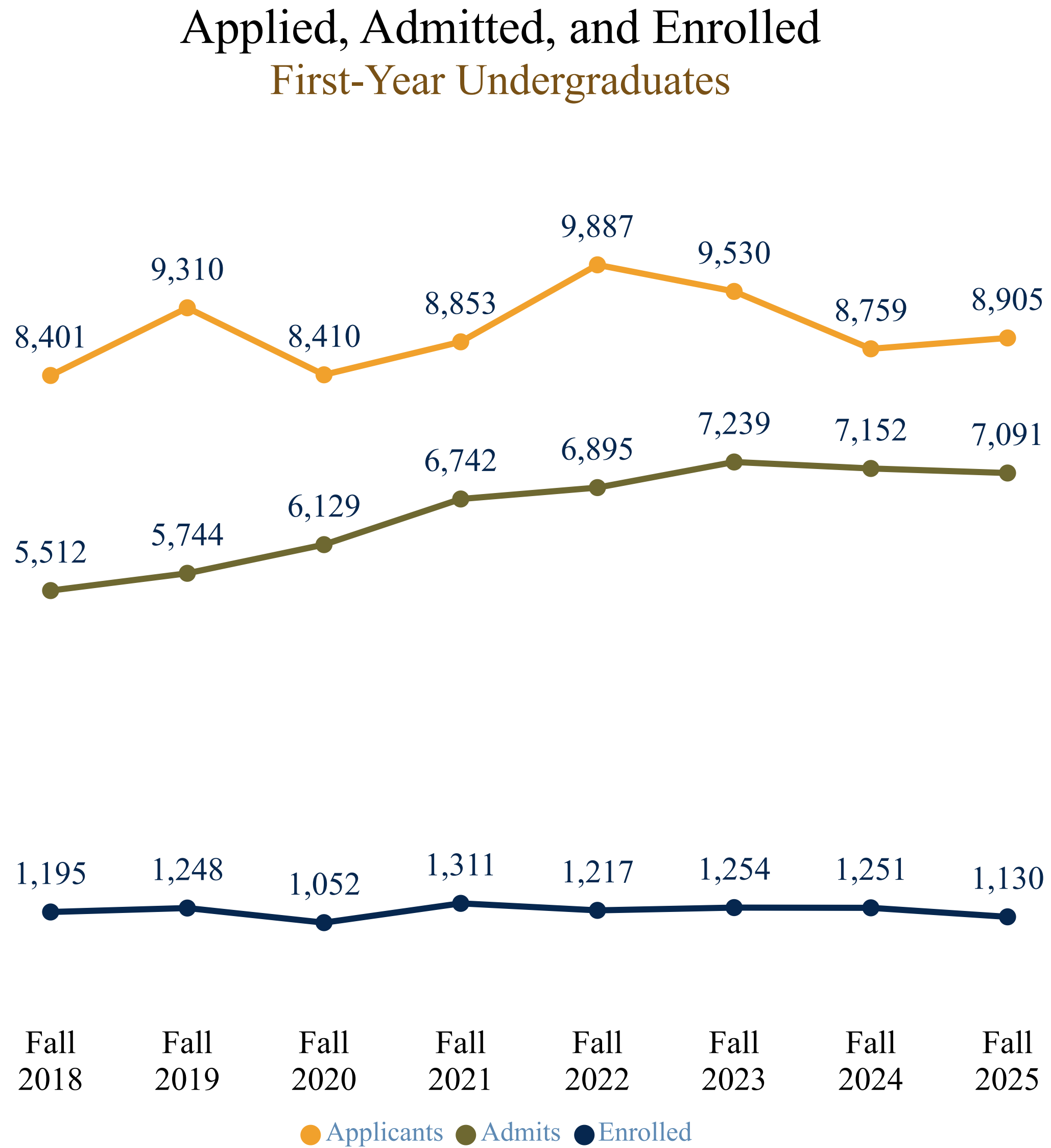

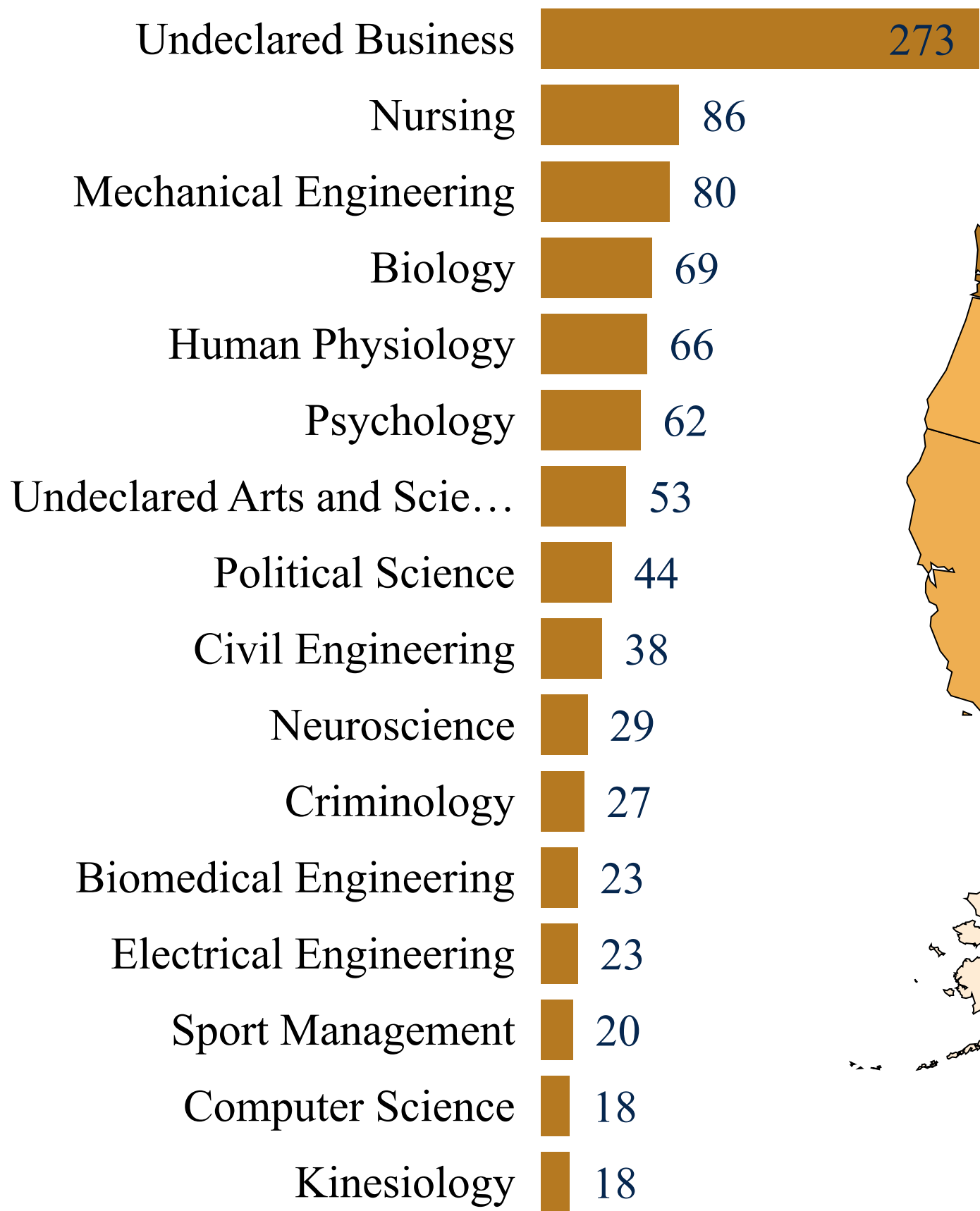

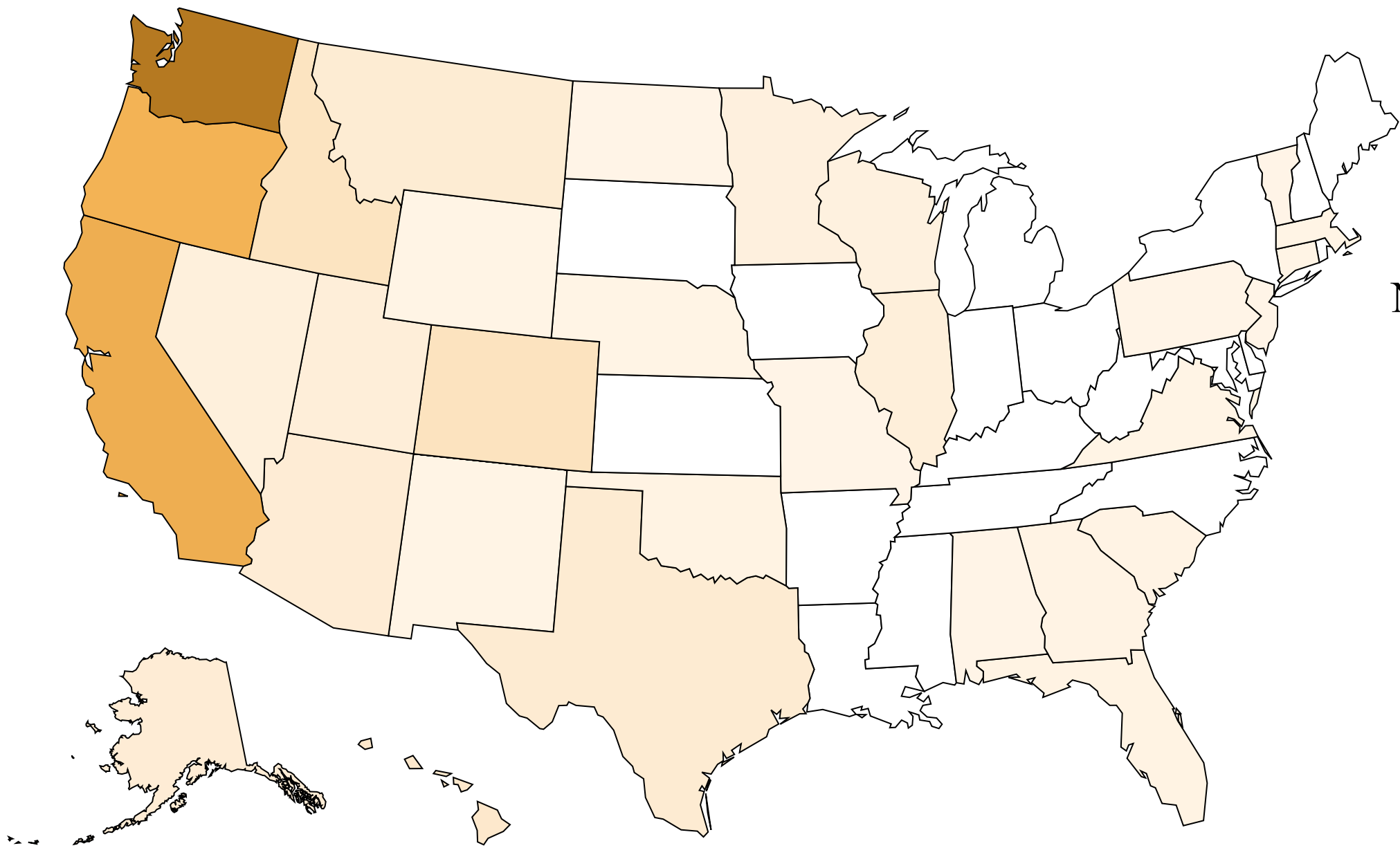

Top 15 New Student Majors, Fall 2025



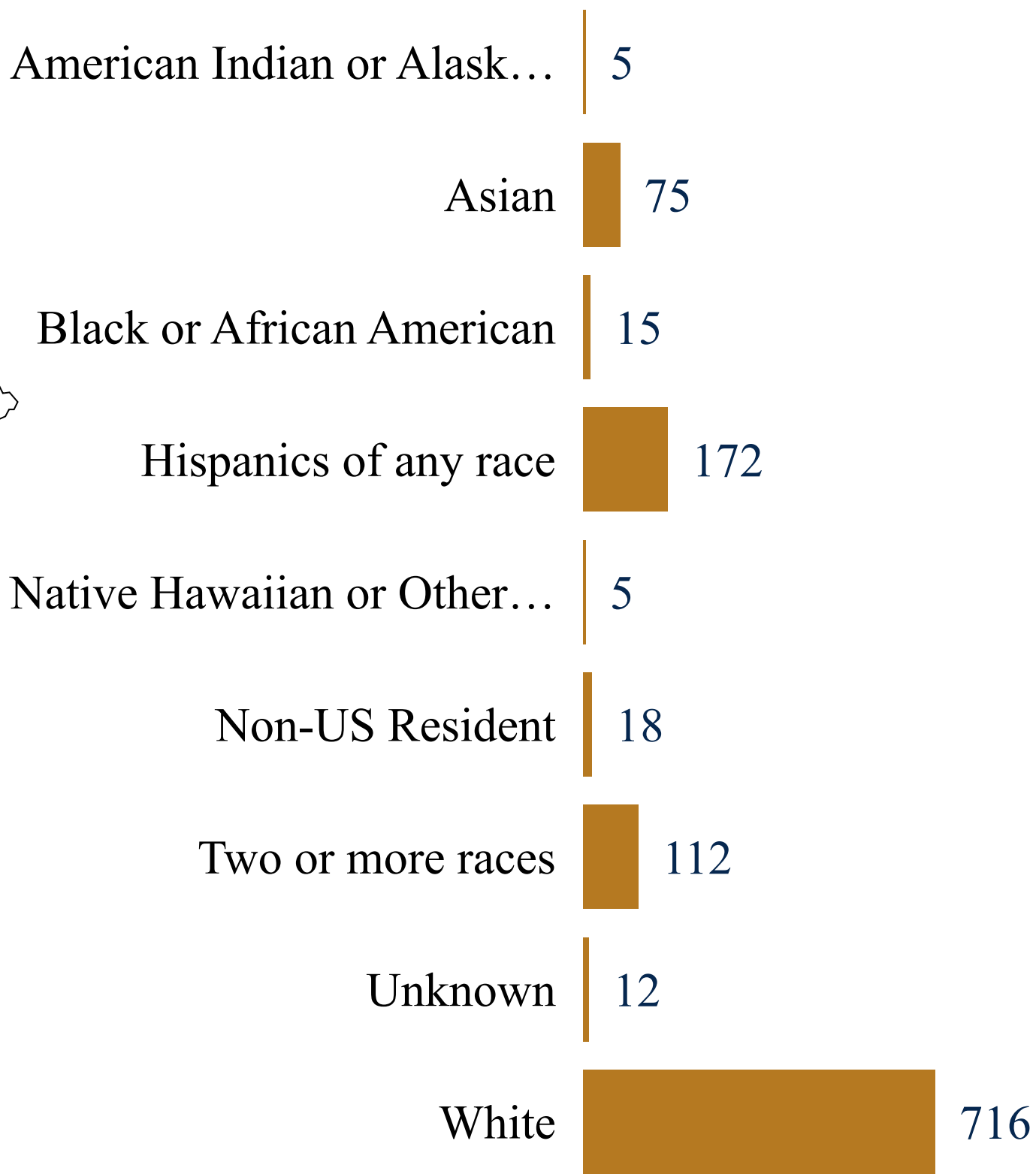
Domestic Origin

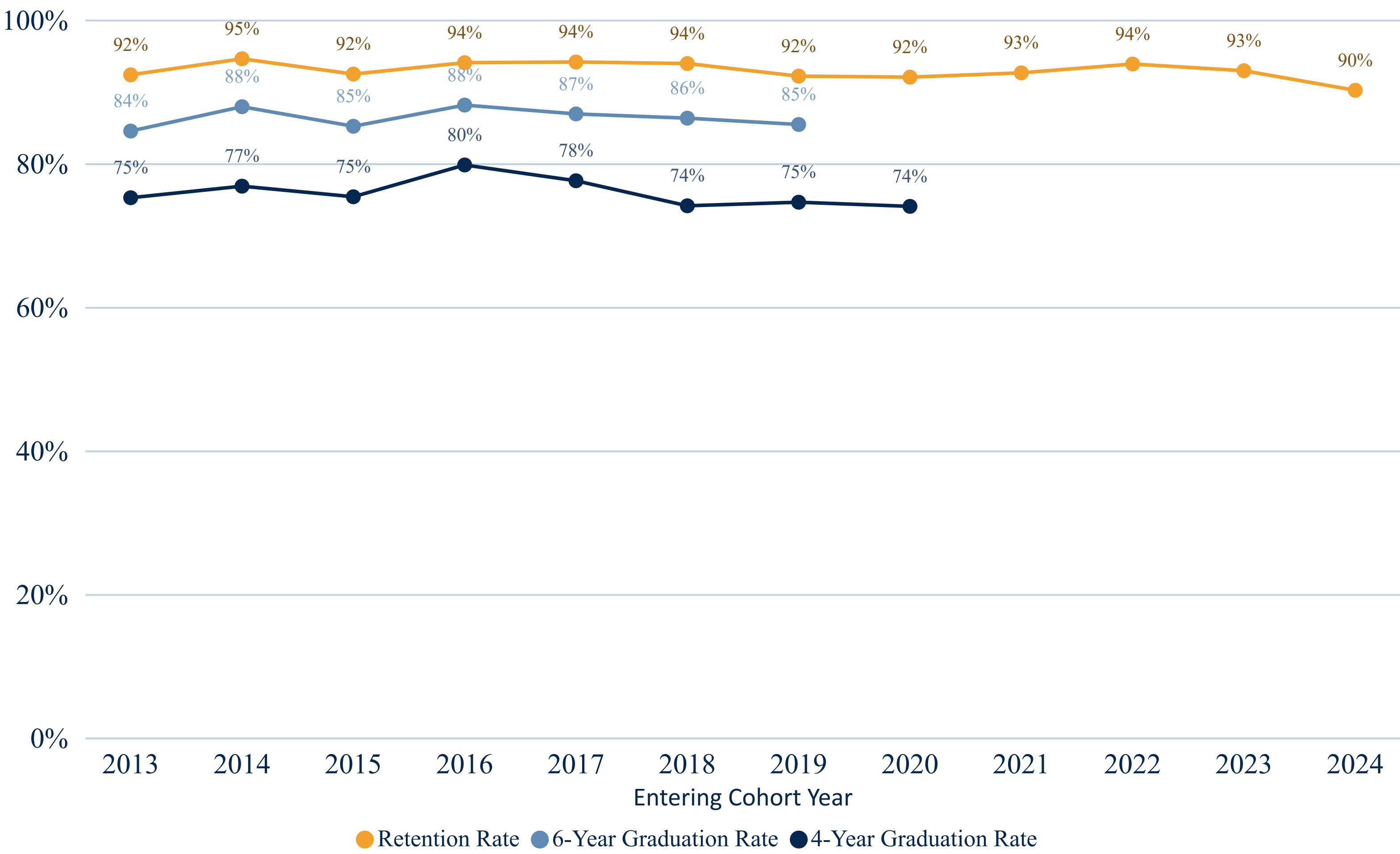

First-time, Full-time Undergraduates by Year of Entry

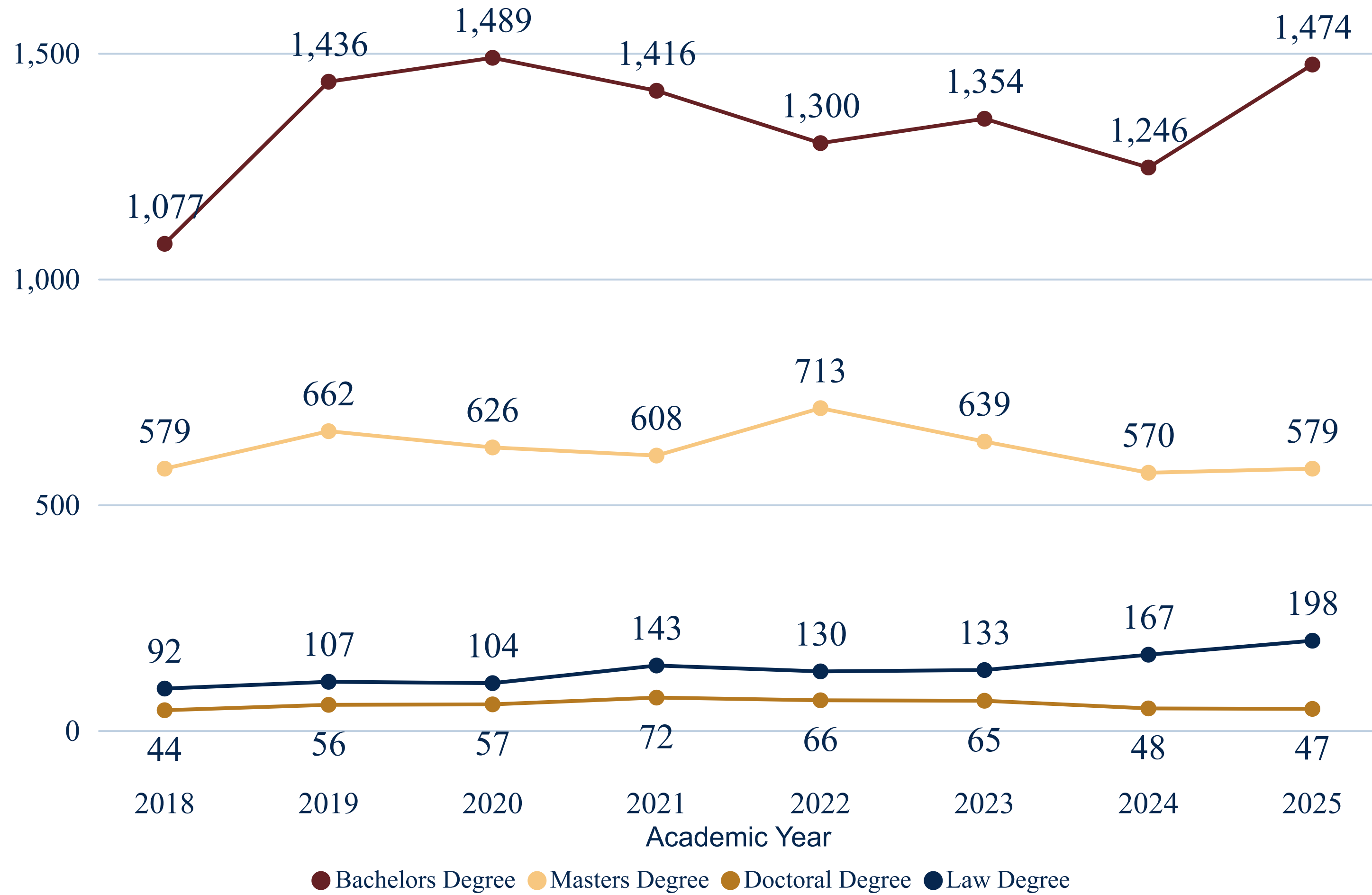


Retention rate is the proportion of first-time, full-time students who enrolled a year after starting at Gonzaga University.

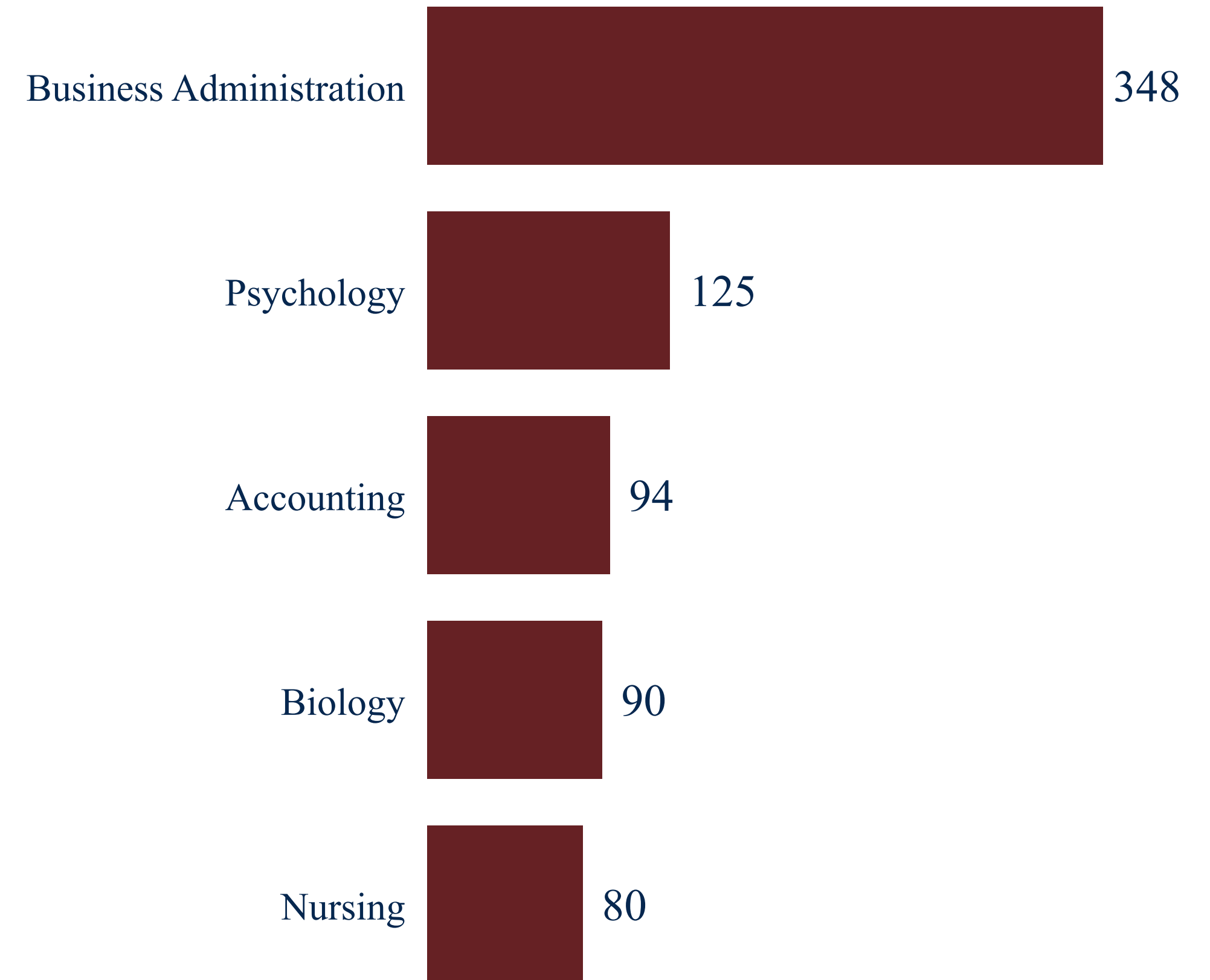
Graduation rate is the proportion of first-time, full-time students who earned their first baccalaureate degrees within 4 or 6 years at Gonzaga University.

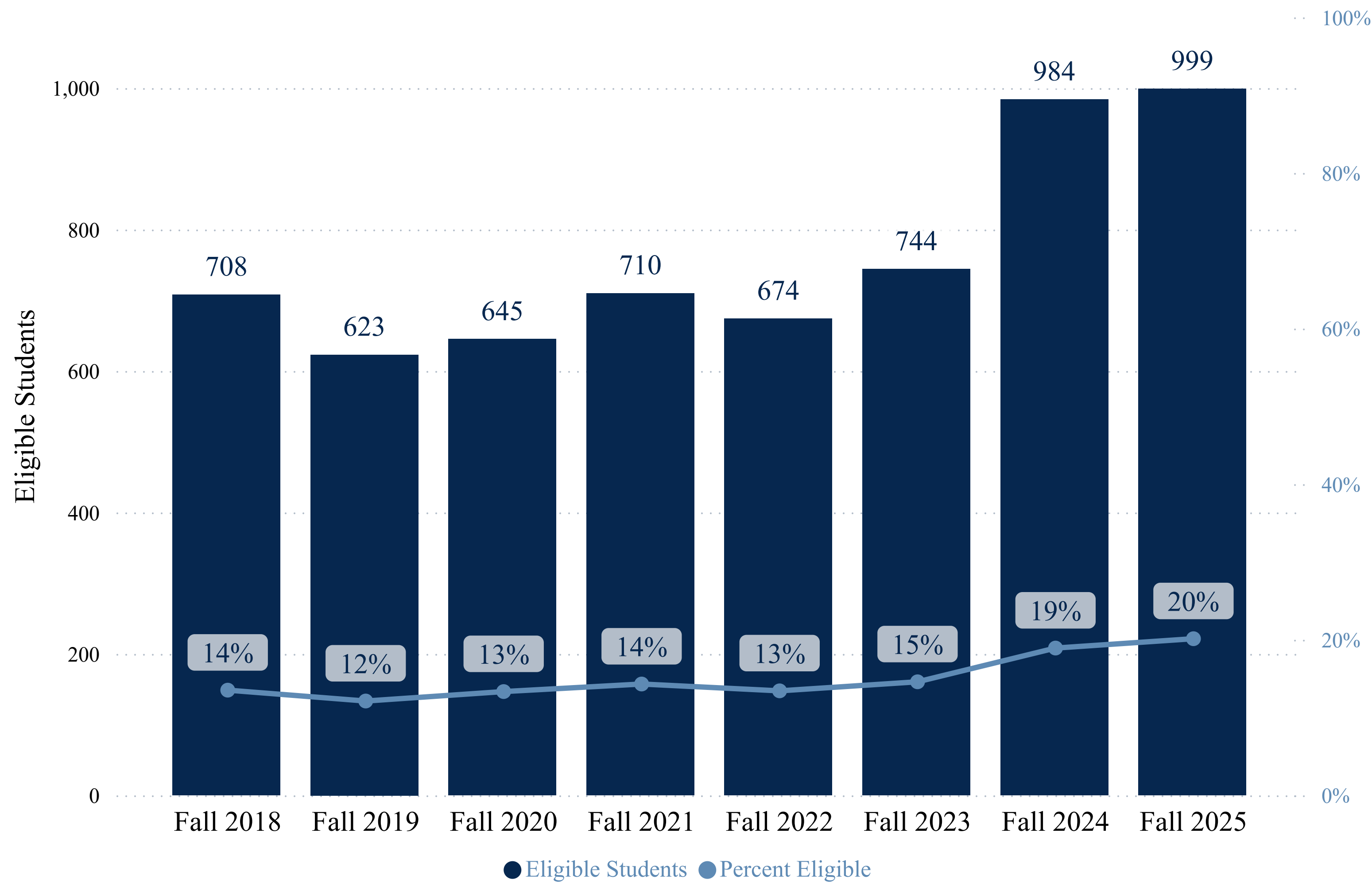

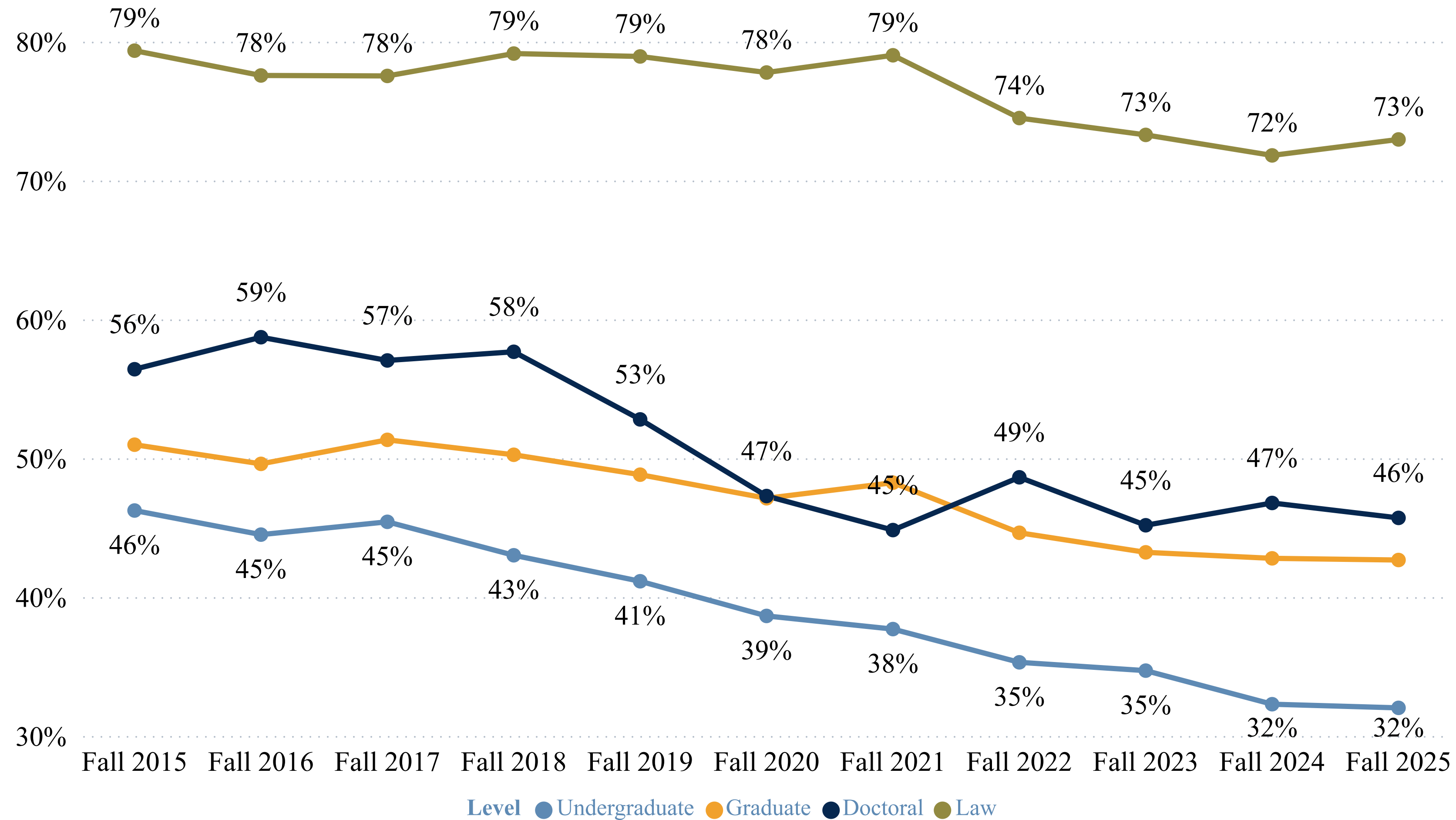

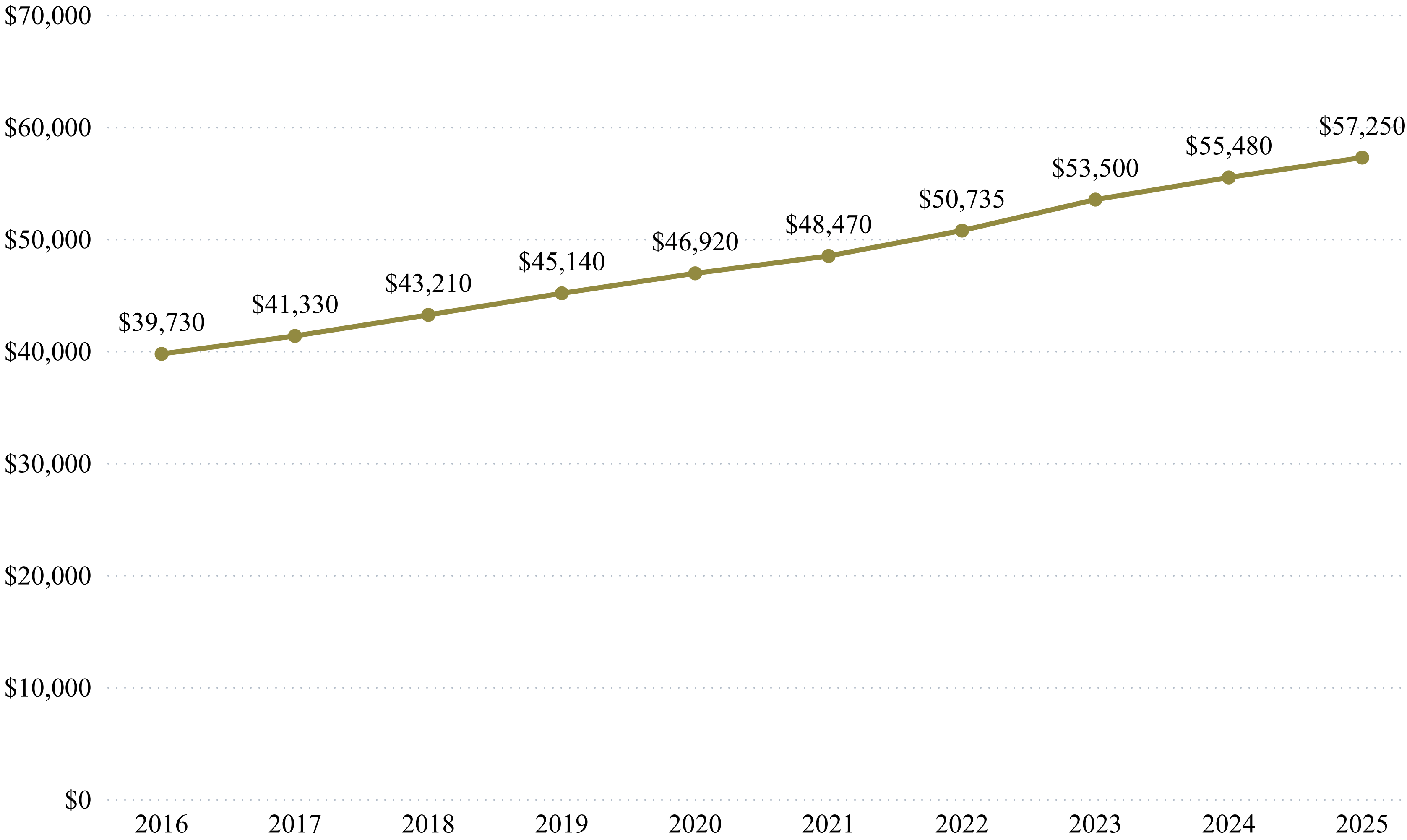


Federal Loans

Percent of Students Receiving Federal Loans 2015 - 2025



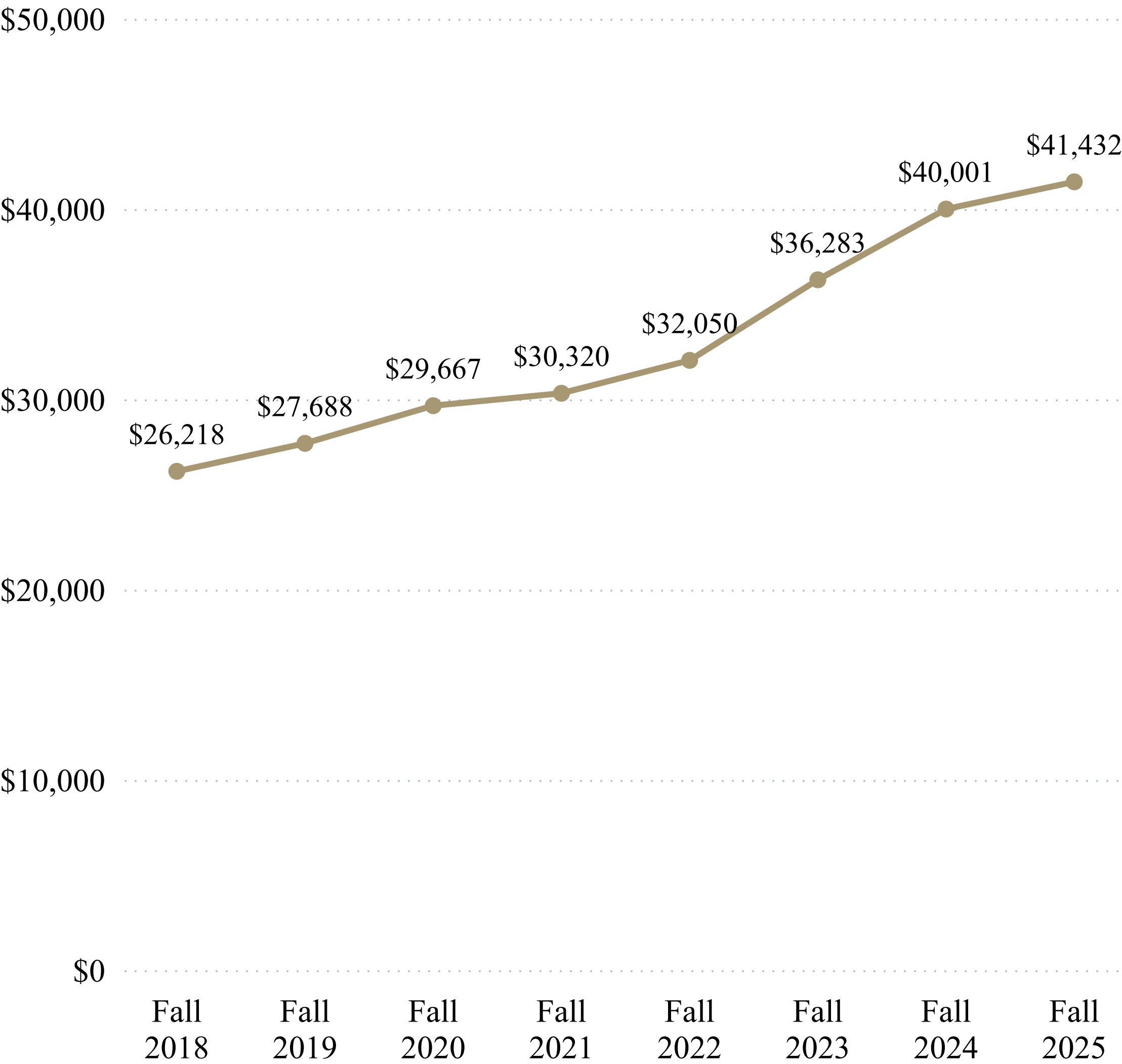
Tuition & Required Fees

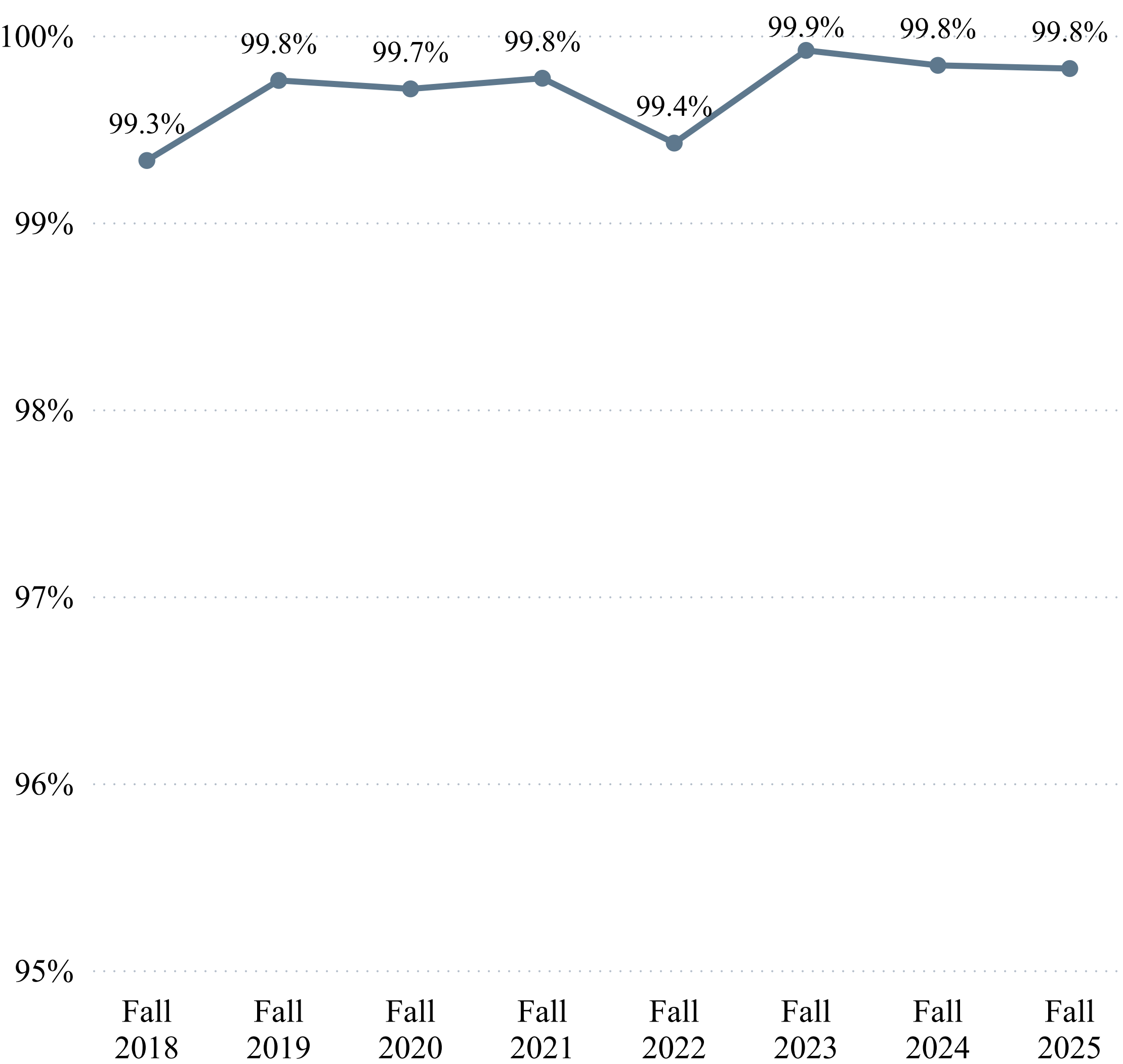

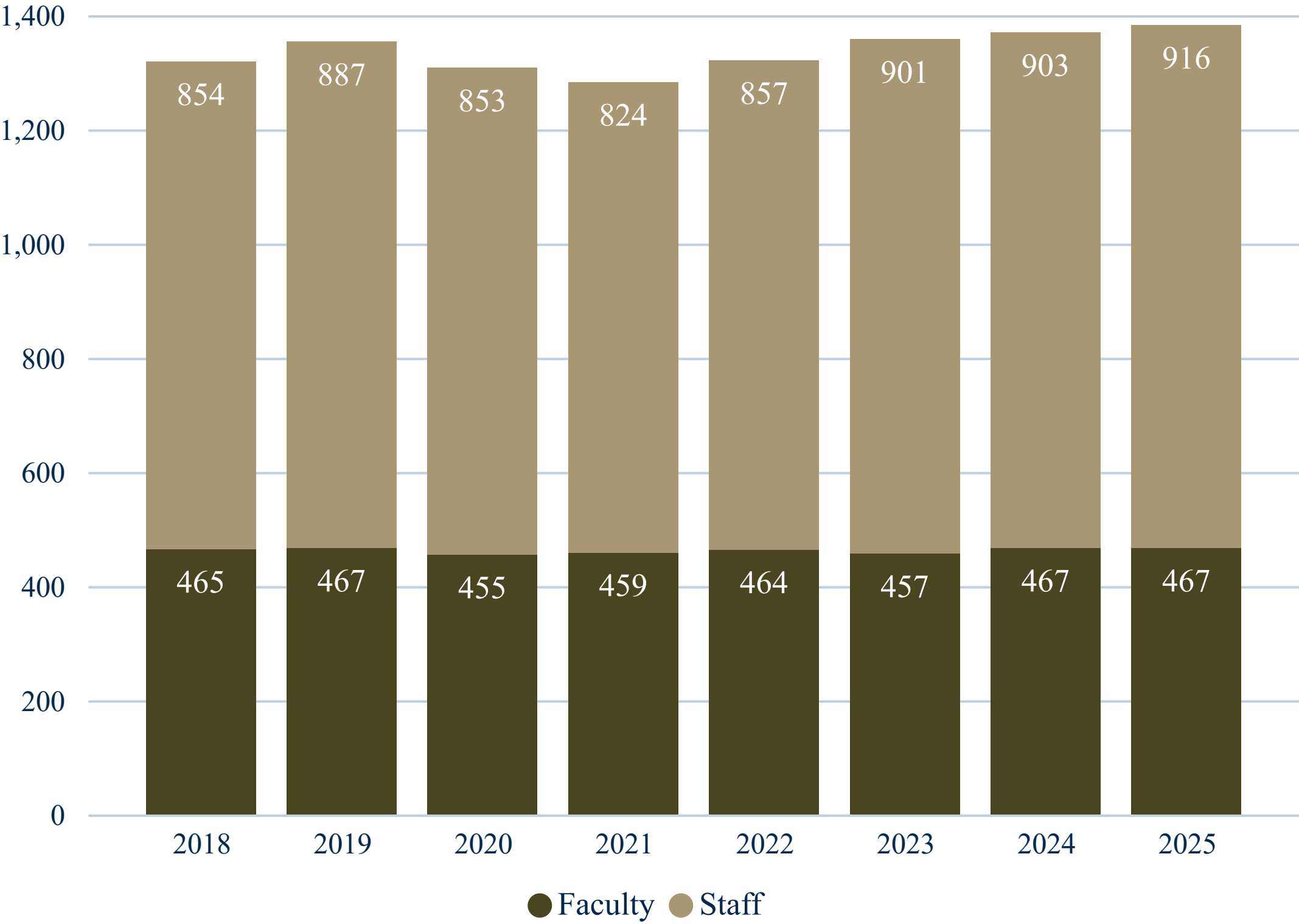

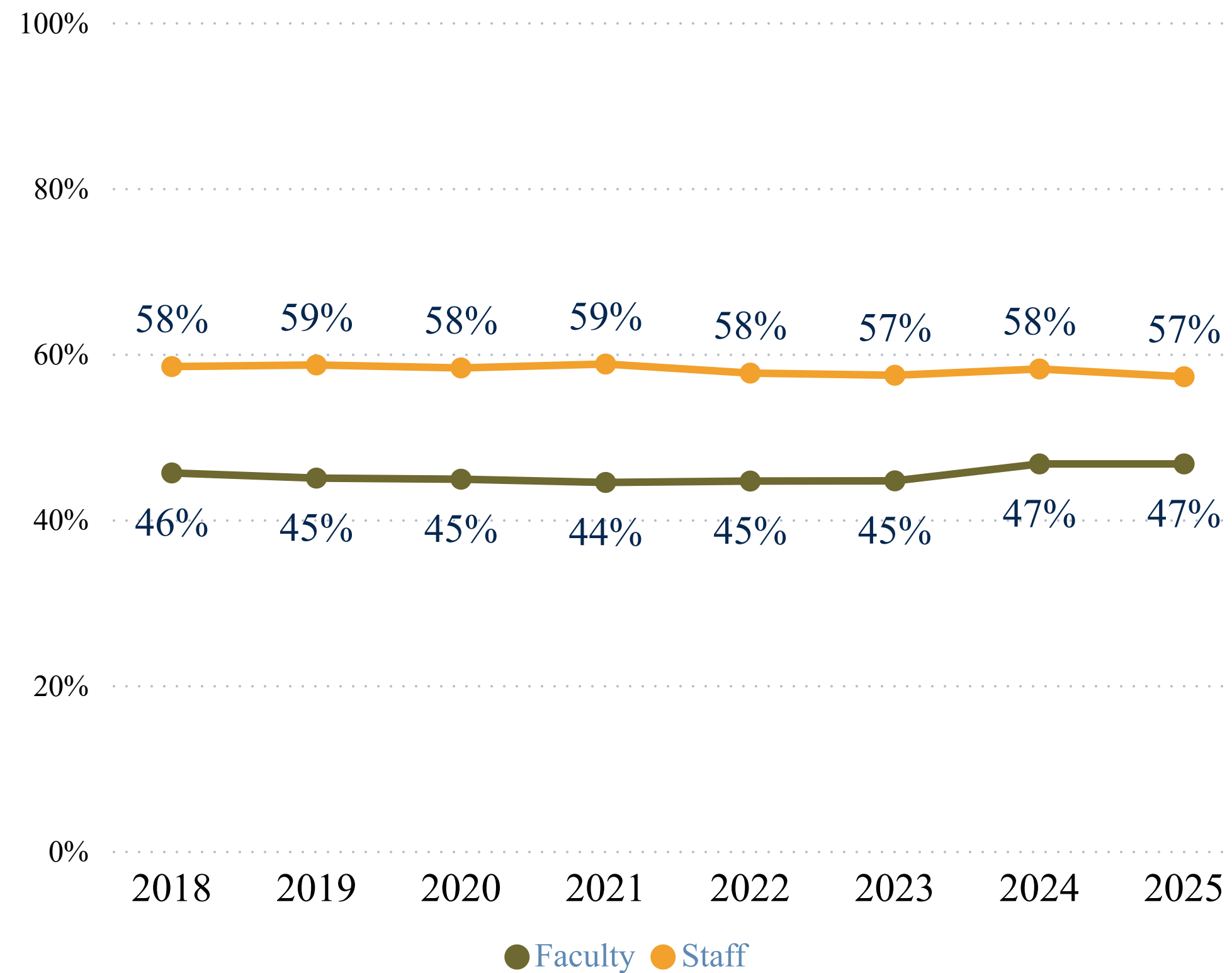

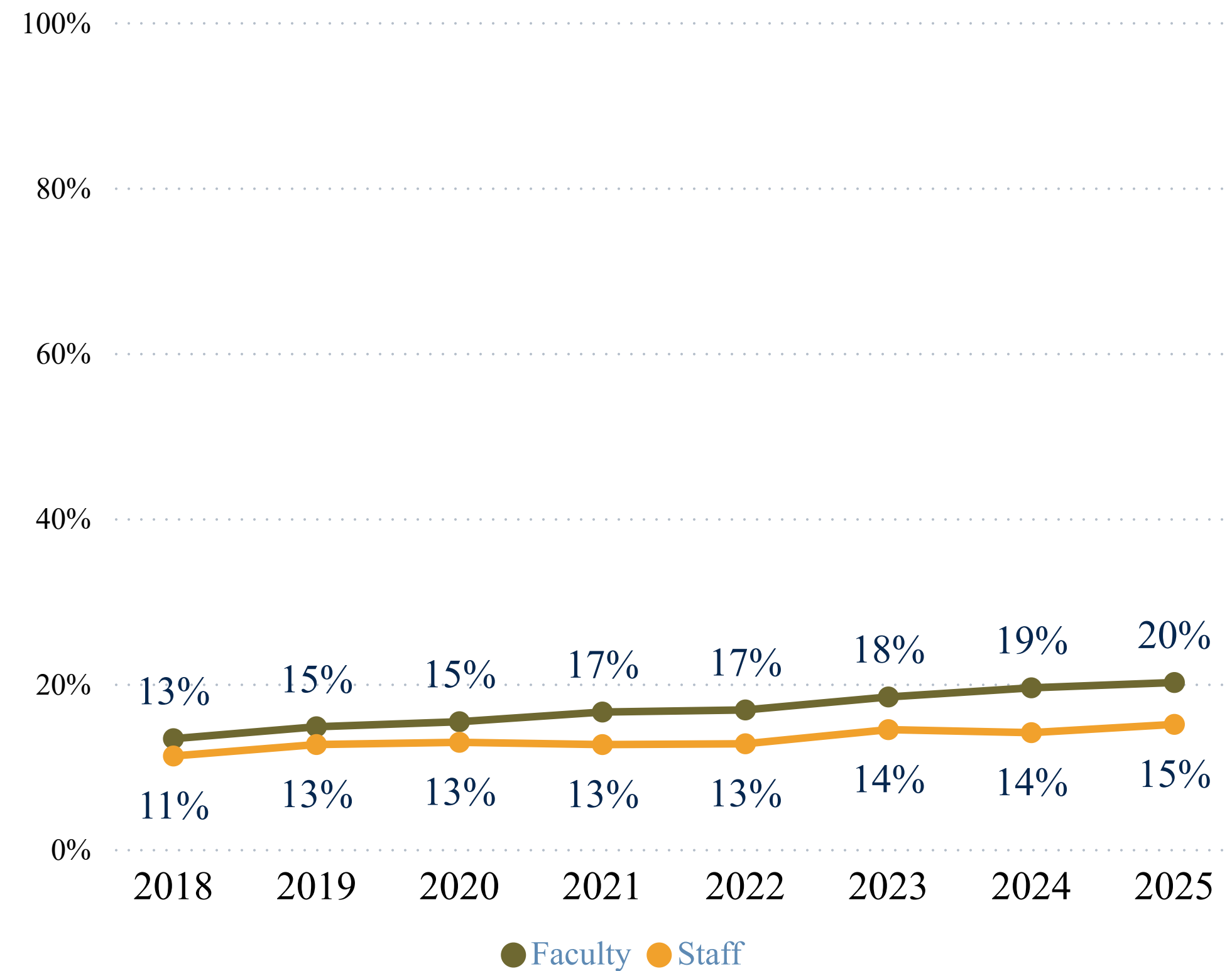
Faculty & Staff Demographics

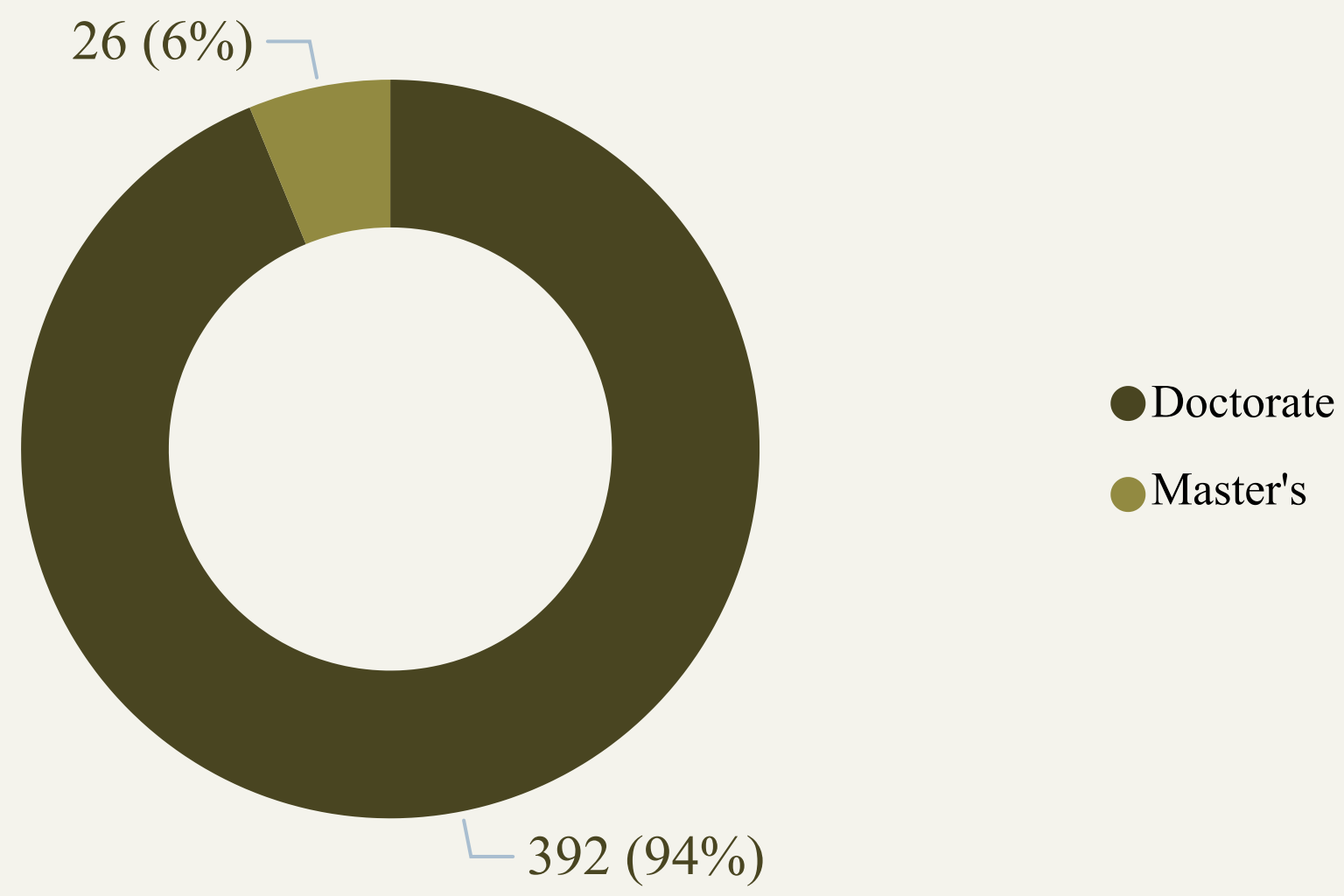

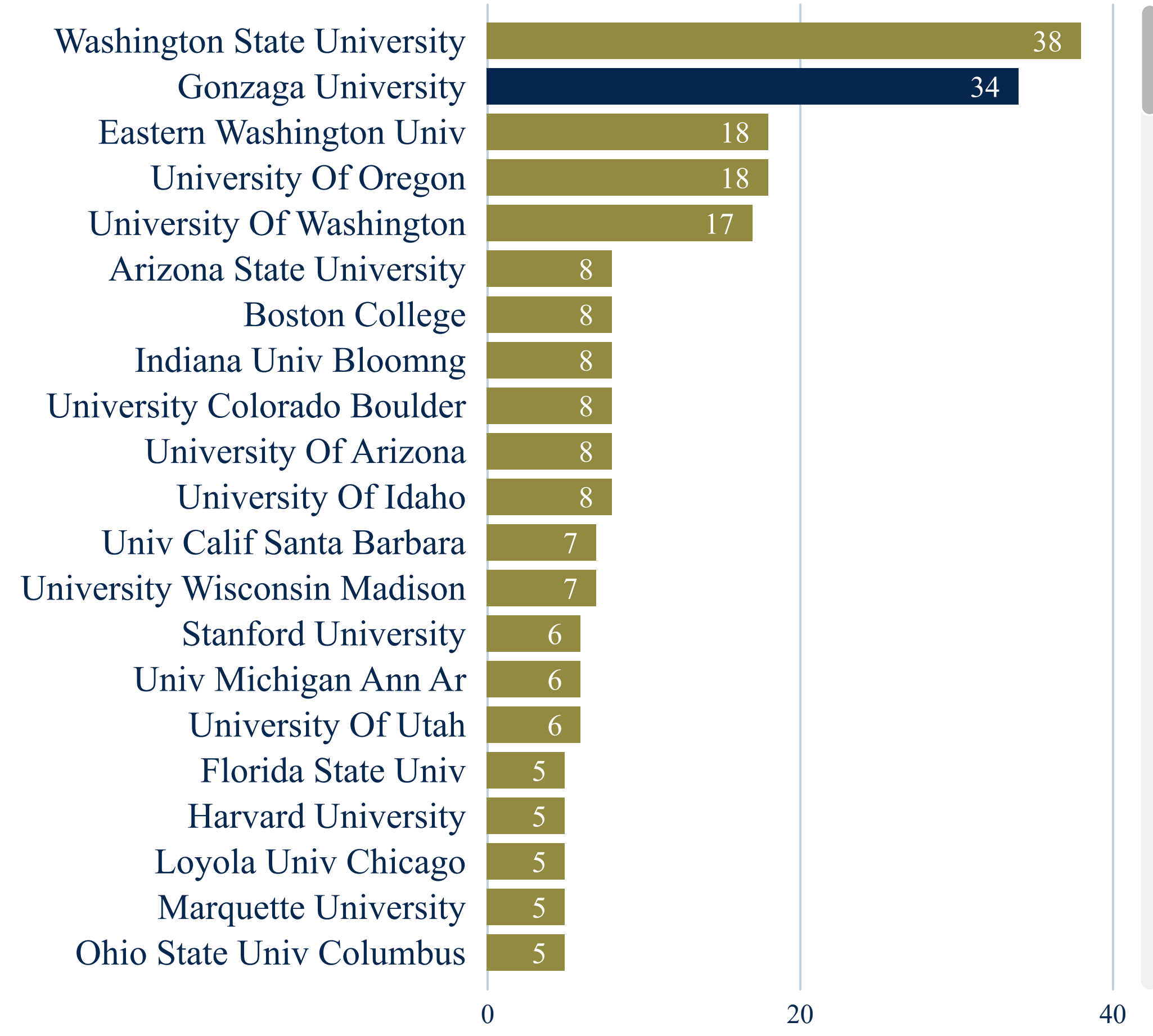
