










Headcount by Time Status





Race and Ethnicity Count of Students, Fall 2025





Percentage by Level, Fall 2018 - 2025




Student Age




Headcount by Transfer Status

Transfer Students Percentage of Undergraduates, Fall 2018 - 2025




Transfer Student Demographics Undergraduates, Fall 2025









Acceptance & Yield Rates






Domestic Origin


Retention rate and 4- and 6-year graduation rates.


Retention Rate, 4-year and 6-year Graduation Rates First-time, Full-time Undergraduates by Year of Entry




Retention rate is the proportion of first-time, full-time students who enrolled a year after starting at Gonzaga University.








Tuition & Required Fees Undergraduate, 2016 - 2025






Average Aid Awarded








