





## Headcount by Level Fall 2015 - 2021





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




Percentage by Student Level, Fall 2015 - 2021














#### Acceptance and Yield Rates








## Race and Ethnicity First-Year Undergraduates, Fall 2021




#### Religious/Faith Traditions

#### Percent by Female/Male\*








