










# Race and Ethnicity Count of Students, Fall 2024





# First Generation Students Percentage of Undergraduates, Fall 2017 - 2024




# First Generation Students as Percentage of their Race/Ethnicity Population









First-Year Undergraduates, Fall 2017 - 2024




The **Acceptance Rate** is the number of admitted students divided by the number of applications received. The **Yield Rate** is the number of new enrolled students divided by the number of accepted students.







# Retention Rate, 4-year and 6-year Graduation Rates First-time, Full-time Undergraduates by Year of Entry




**Retention rate** is the proportion of first-time, full-time students who enrolled a year after starting at Gonzaga University.


**Graduation rate** is the proportion of first-time, full-time students who earned their first baccalaureate degrees within 4 or 6 years at Gonzaga University.





# Percent of Students Receiving Federal Loans 2014 - 2024








First-Time Full-Time Undergraduates, 2017 - 2024




#### Students Receiving Aid by Cohort

Faculty and Staff Headcount Fall 2017 - 2024







Percentage of Employees, Fall 2016 - 2024





# Underrepresented Minority\*\* Percentage of Employees, Fall 2016 - 2024


