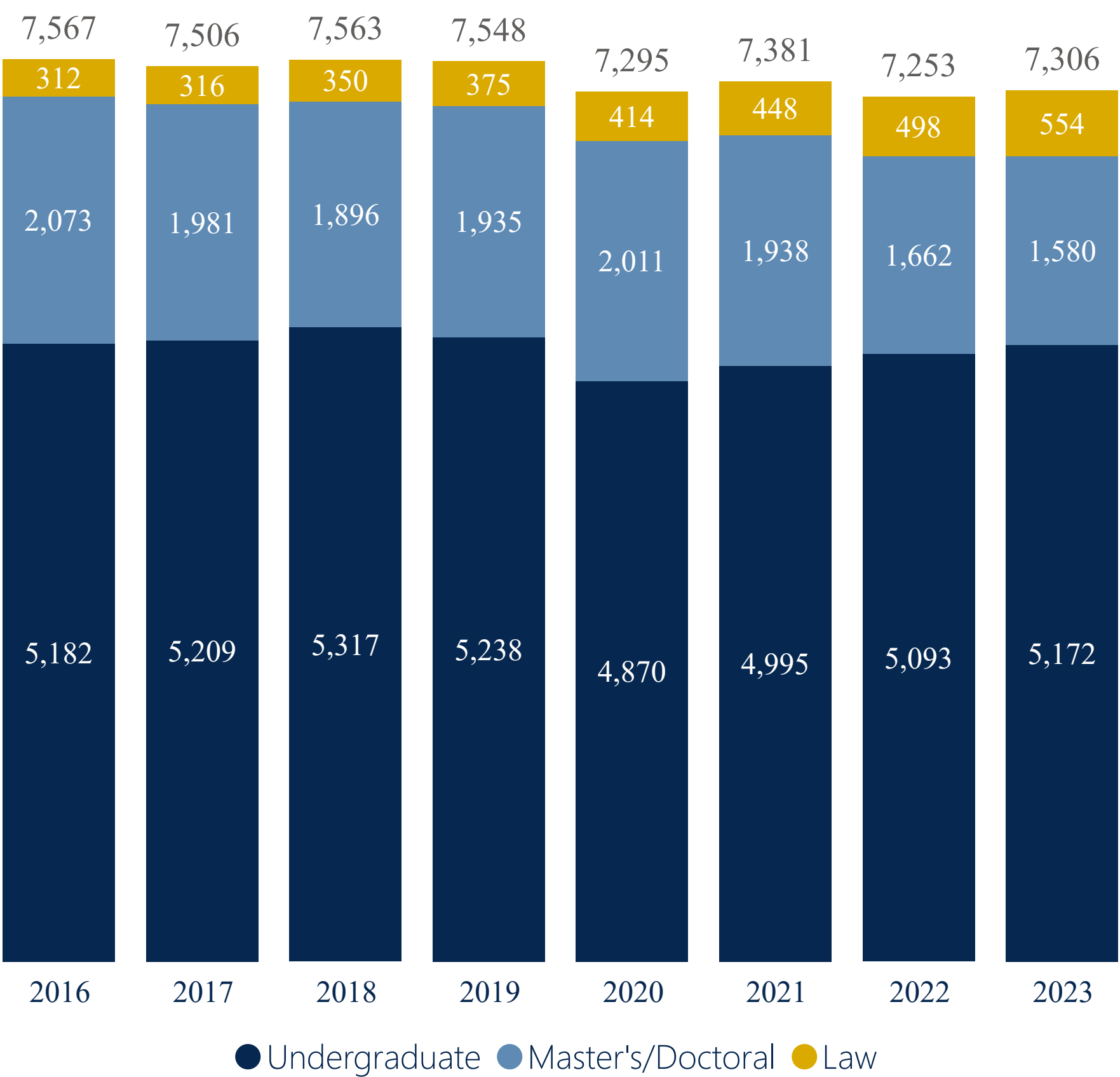

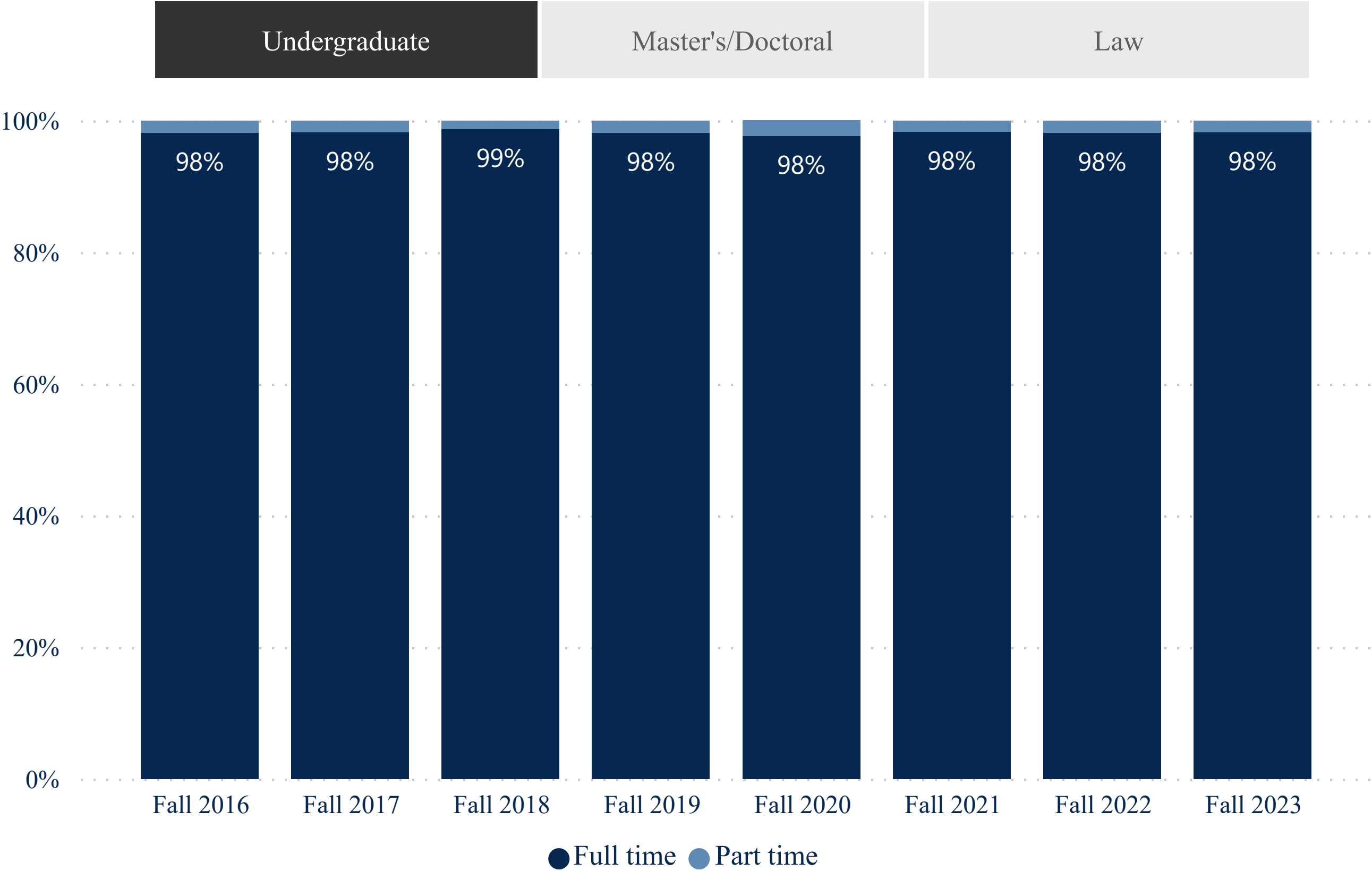

Number of Students, Fall 2023

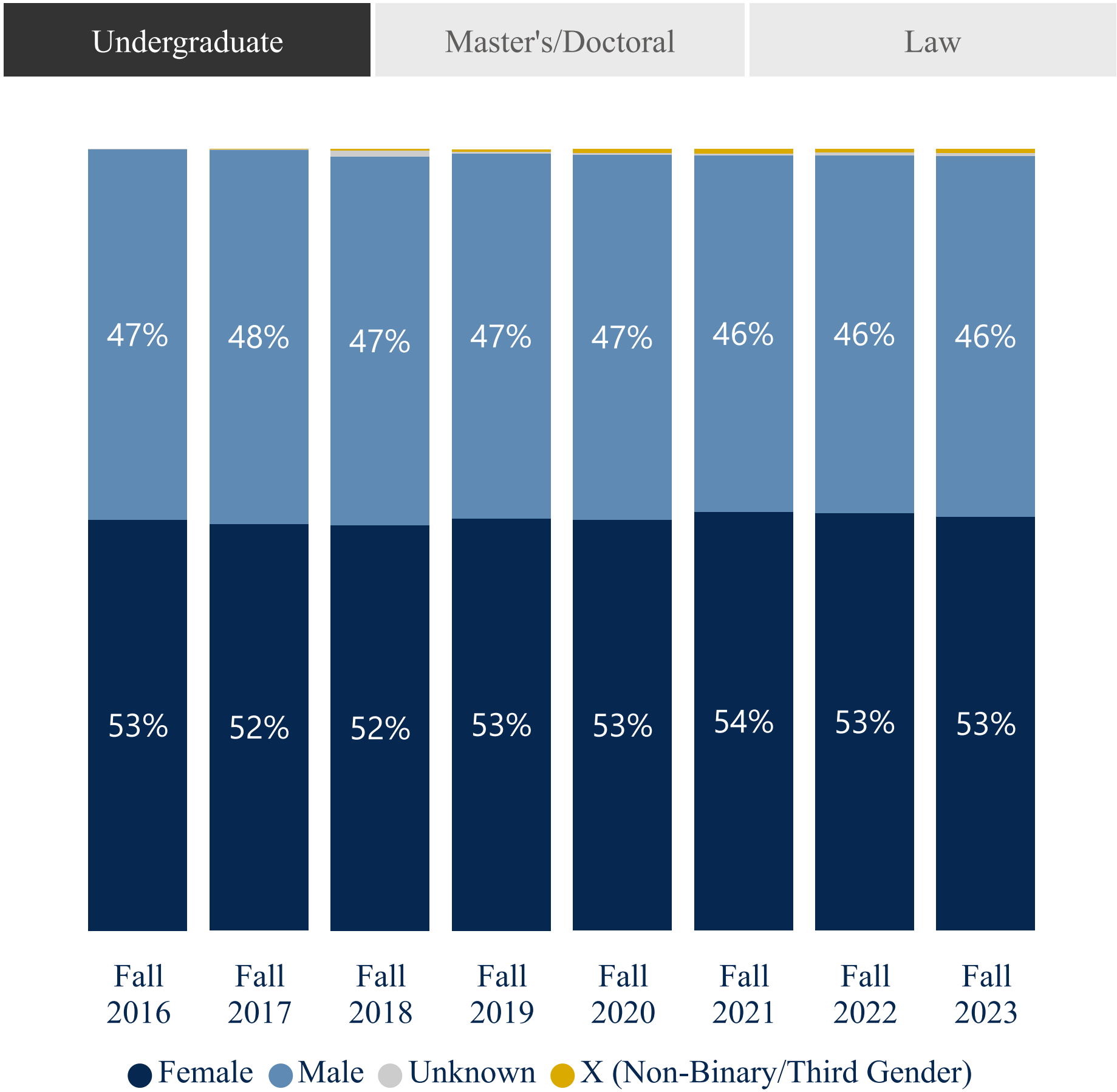

Percentage by Level, Fall 2016 - 2023



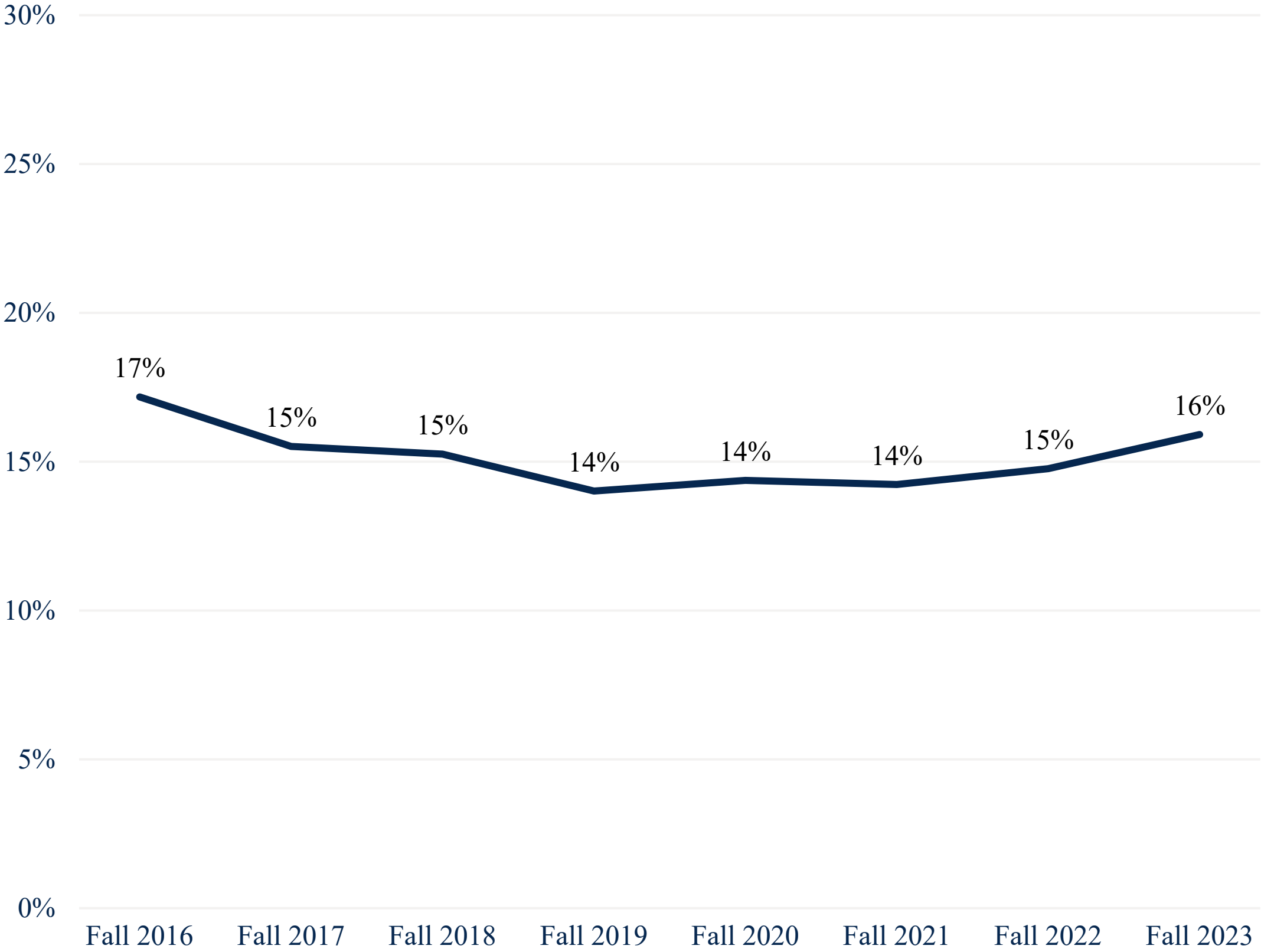
Student Age  
Distribution by Level, Fall 2023



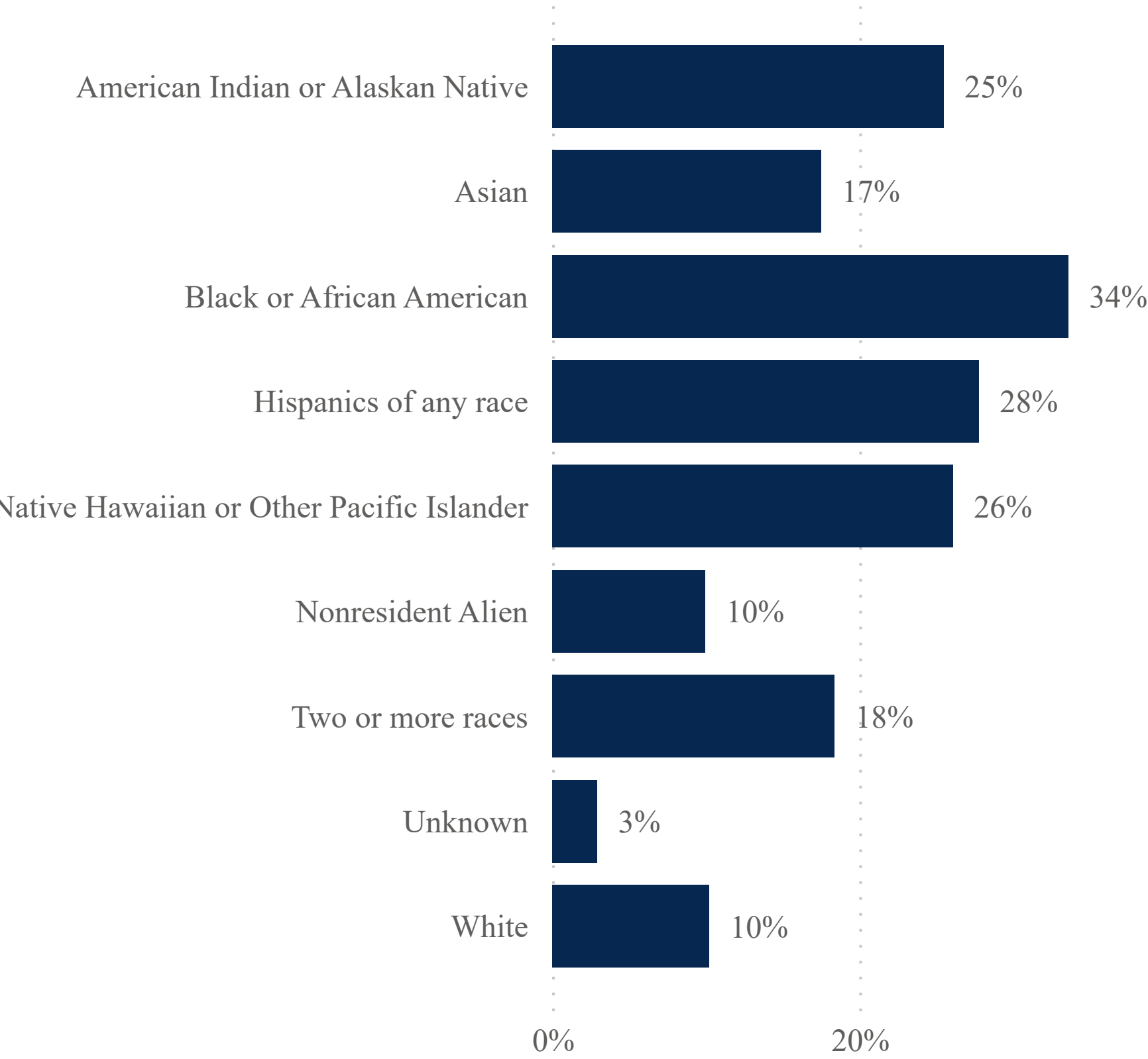

Percentage of Undergraduates, Fall 2016 - 2023

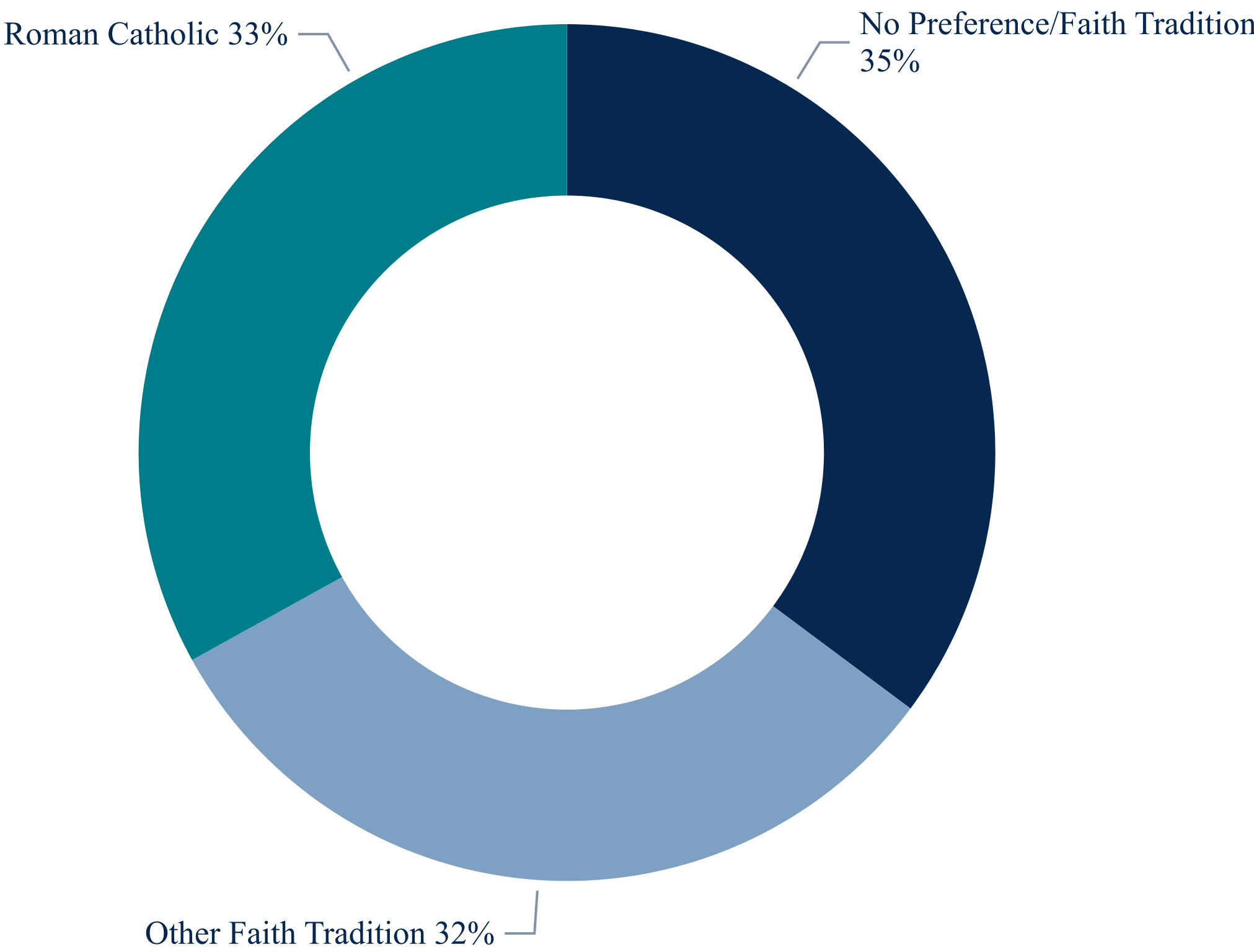


First Generation Students as Percentage of

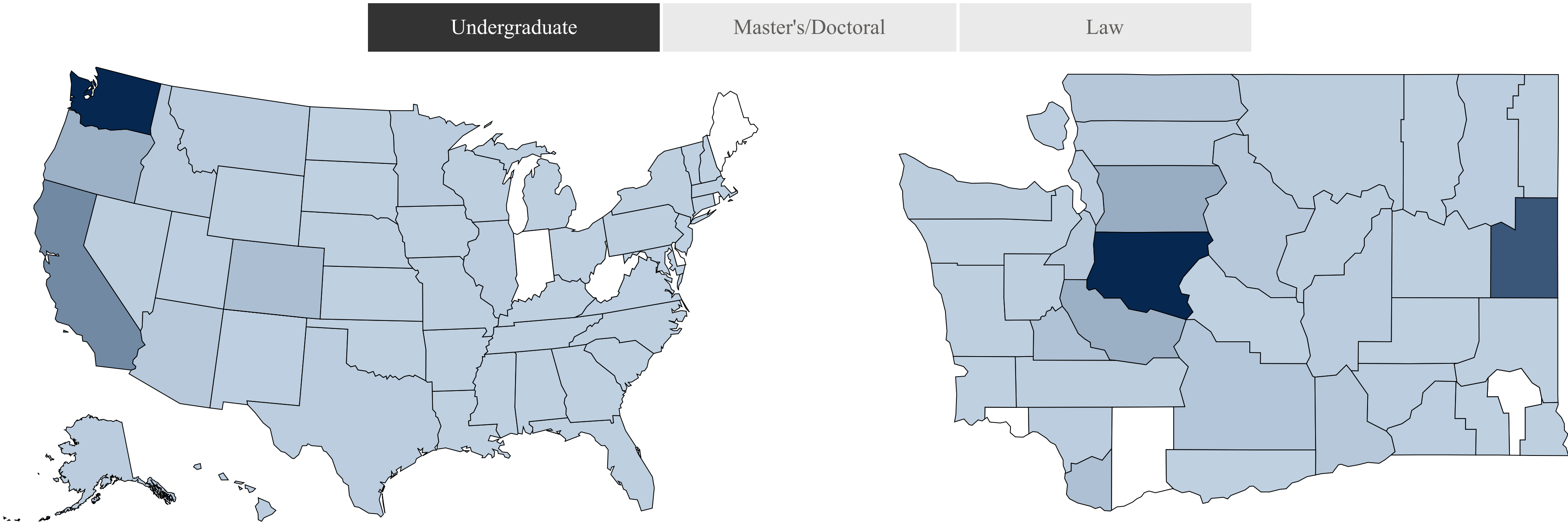

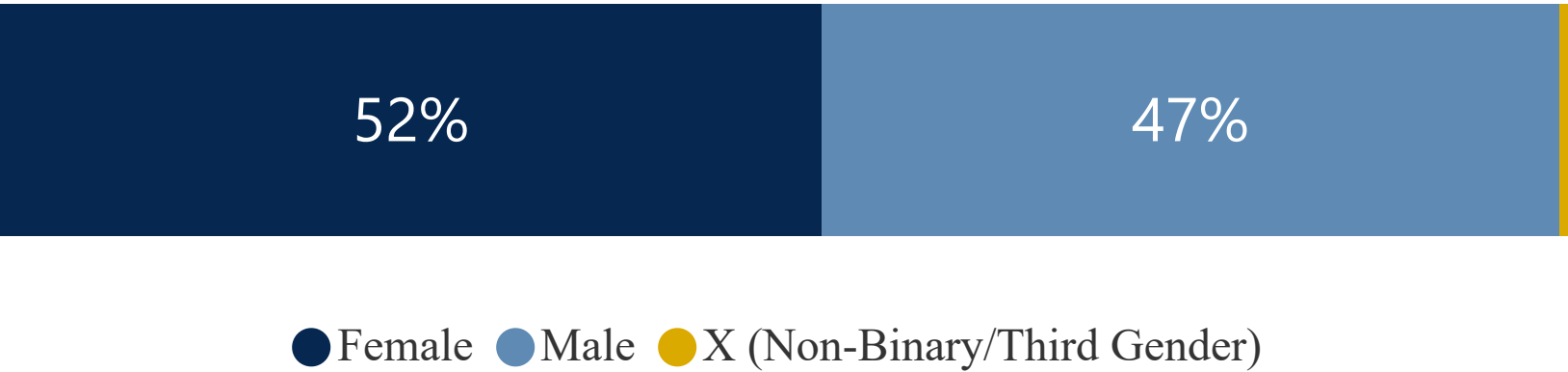

First-Year Undergraduates, Fall 2023







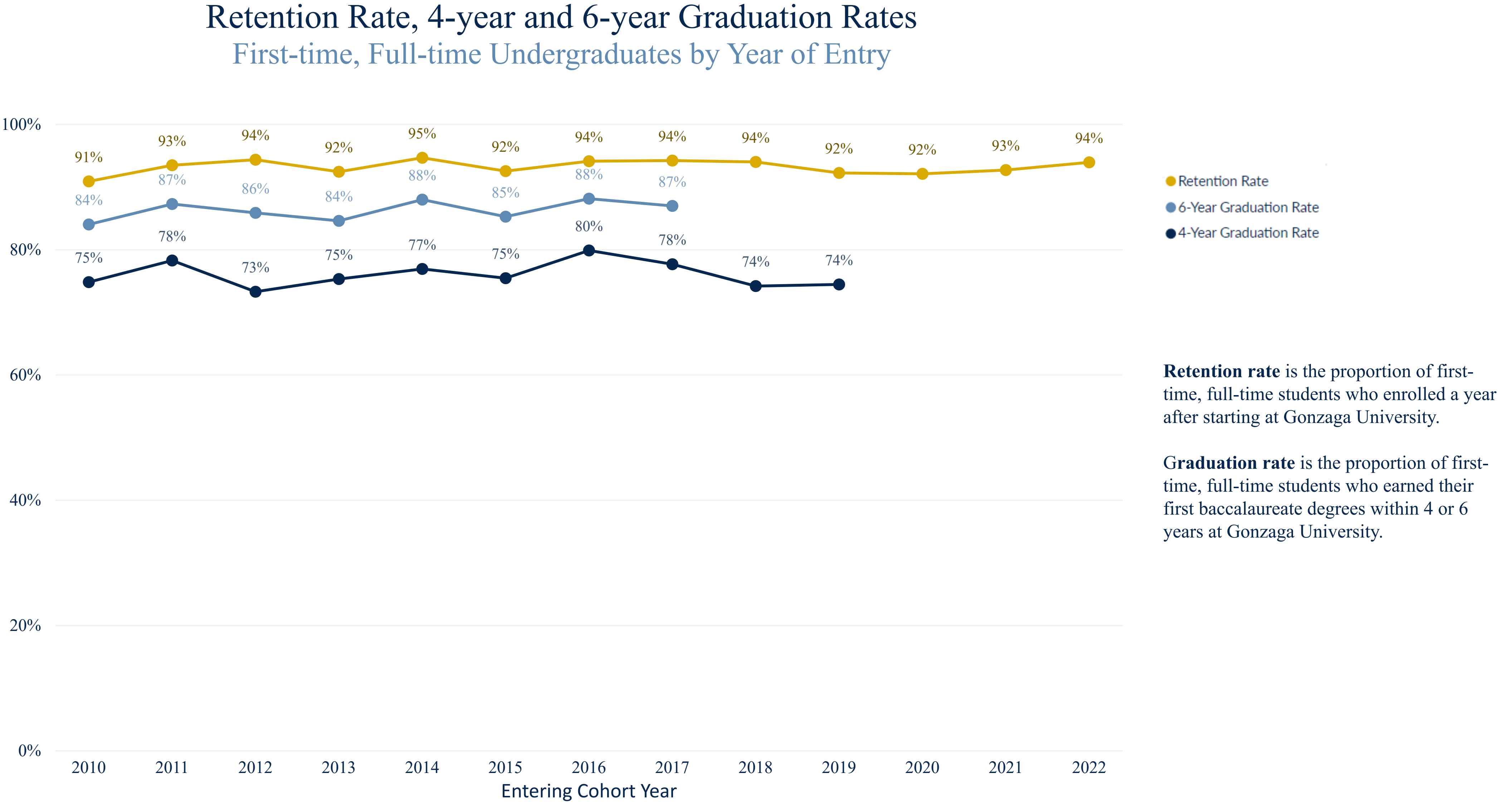

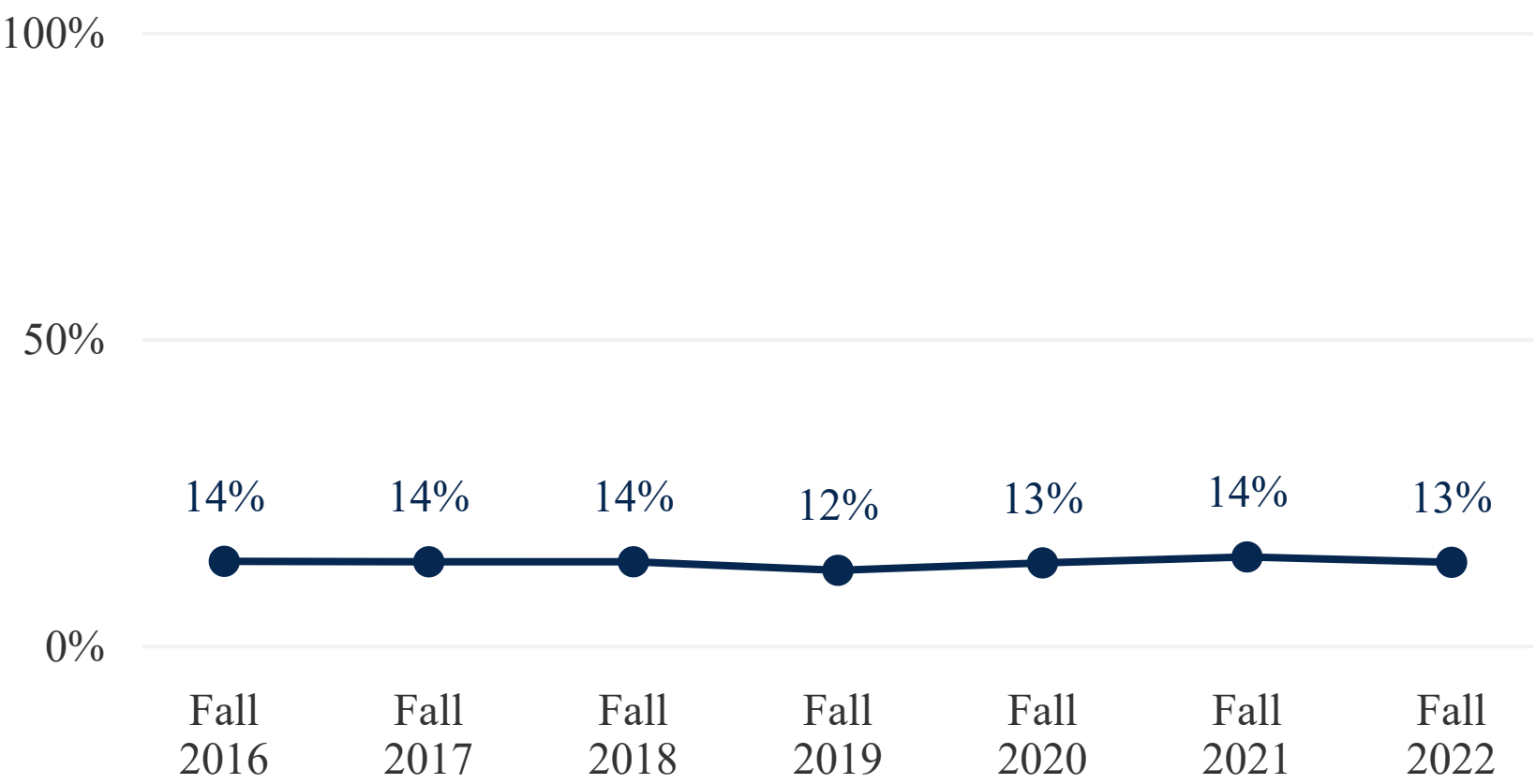

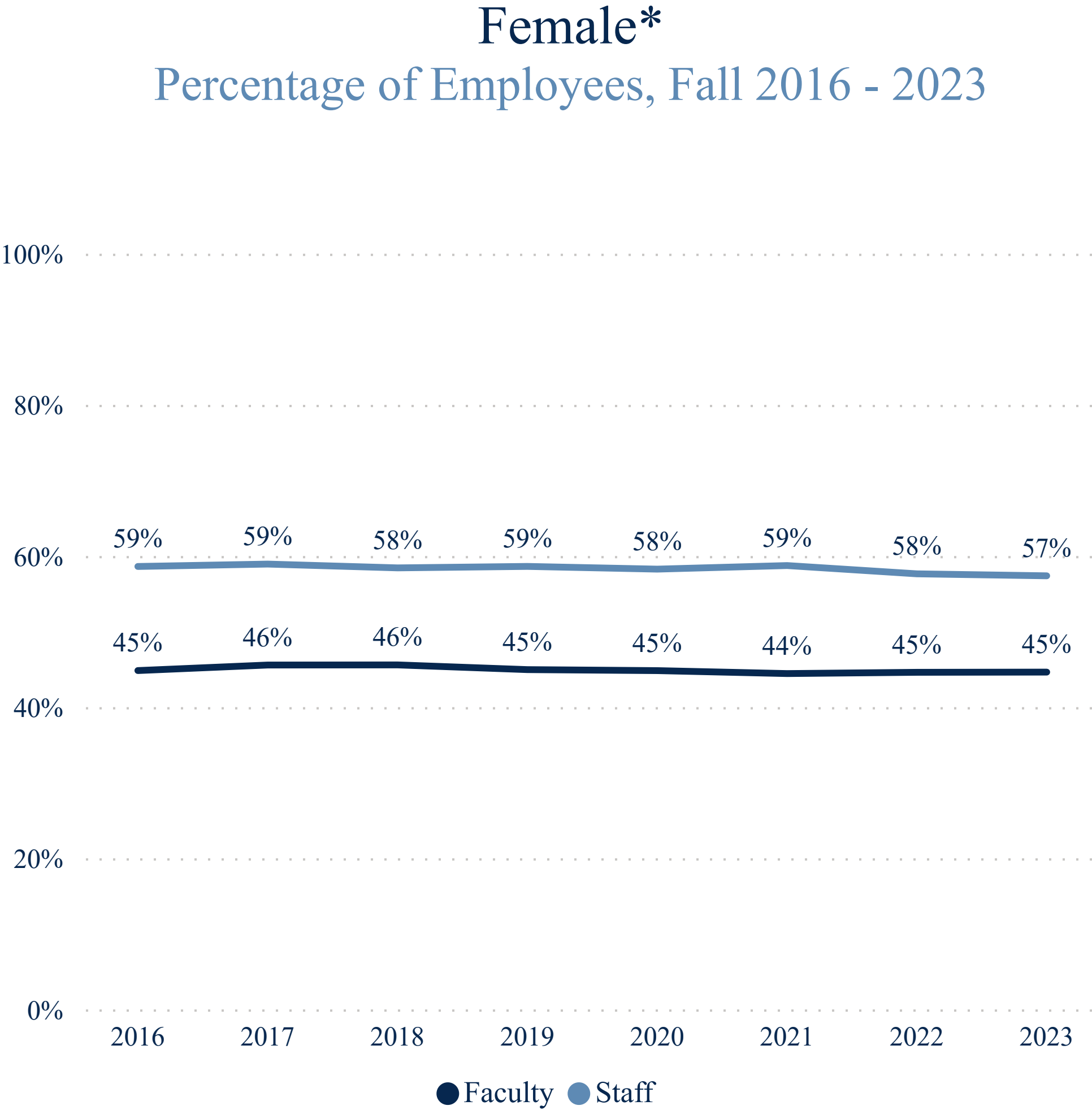
