

# STUDY ABROAD AT GONZAGA



Gonzaga University is a private, Jesuit Catholic University located in Spokane, Washington. Established in 1887, the university has over 75 fields of study. Gonzaga is ranked as the No. 80 best university in the U.S. according to U.S. News & World Report College Rankings. Gonzaga is known for its philosophy of educating the whole personmind, body, and spirit.

Our Academic ESL Program offers ESL sessions year-round, and includes students from a variety of countries and language backgrounds. The program offers 21 hours of intensive language instruction per week, including reading, writing, listening, speaking, and grammar skills.

Our ESL + Undergraduate and Undergraduate visiting student options include multilingual course options, language and culture support courses, liberal arts courses, and courses in a variety of majors.

## **Program Options**

The Year Abroad Program is designed for students to attend as little as one semester or two sessions up to three semesters.

#### **ESL**

ESL classes allow for entry in the first or second session as well as departure after Session I. ESL course levels offered is based on current enrollments and availability will vary. Students beginning in the ESL program will participate in an ESL Orientation during their first session.

#### ESL + UNDERGRADUATE and UNDERGRADUATE

Combination ESL + Undergraduate and Undergraduate courses span the entire semester and require Session I entry. Students will participate in Freshman Orientation and First Year Experience programs during their first Fall or Spring semester in Combination ESL + undergraduate or Undergraduate. Students qualifying for Undergraduate courses in their first term will be required to take Writing for Multilingual International Students.

#### PLACEMENT

Student will be placed in an appropriate ESL Level based on availability and English Language test scores submitted as part of the application. All students will be given the ELC Placement Test during Orientation to confirm the most appropriate level of ESL course work.

## 2022-2023 Cost Estimates

Cost Estimates have been rounded to the nearest dollar. Please note that fees can vary by session or term, and as a result actual fees may vary. There are two ESL sessions per semester. Cost shown is for two sessions. Students are billed by session.
