- Buy your plane tickets- confirm that your final destination is Spokane, WA, airport code GEG. Be aware of the following dates:

Fall 2022:

Move in and airport pickup date: **August 22, 2022**

Orientation dates: **August 23, 2022 - August 26, 2022**

Spring 2023:

Move in & airport pick up date: **January 10, 2023**

Orientation dates: **January 11, 2023 - January 16, 2023**

Summer 2023:

Move in & Airport pick up: **May 15, 2023**

Orientation dates: **May 16, 2023 - May 19, 2023**

 - f. Confirmation of your airport pick up or alternative plans
