



Gonzaga University's Principal Certification Program requires a 600 hours Internship. The Internship takes place from August through June and includes experiences that take place during the school day and outside of the regular school schedule. It is the responsibility of the intern to meet that requirement.

All interns can apply for a competitive AWSP grant that covers roughly 30 days of substitute pay. Interns that do not receive the grant understand they will need to work with their mentor and district to design an internship plan that utilizes vacation, personal leave, etc. to access the types of experiences they need in order to satisfy the hour requirement.
