Note: You will complete most items on this checklist after you receive your class schedule in Zagweb. Student schedules will be assigned late July if all required pre-registration materials have been received. Check your course schedule on Zagweb once you are notified by the Registrar's Office. Stop by the Chastek Library in the Law School during either of the following weeks. Students may also pursue other options including Amazon, Chegg, Valore Books, Bookscounter, etc. Check the First Day Assignments webpage and complete any necessary assignments before the first day of classes, available on myGU early August.
