

Transfer Opportunity Scholarship



The Award:

New transfer students will be selected each year to receive a \$4000 per year scholarship for up to three years. Applicants must be transfer students from other colleges who will be sophomores or juniors upon enrollment at Gonzaga (minimum of 46 quarter or 31 semester credits earned at the time of application) and intend to pursue a Bachelor degree full-time. To retain this scholarship, students must maintain full-time enrollment and meet Satisfactory Academic Progress.

To apply, students must:

- Apply for admission as a **transfer student** by March 1 (for fall) or November 15 (for spring)
First-year applicants with college credit - such as Running Start or College in the High School credit are **not** eligible to apply.
- Complete the Transfer Opportunity Scholarship Application, including the short answer and essay portions by April 1 (for fall) or November 15 (for spring)
- Optional: submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the upcoming academic year and list Gonzaga as one of your school choices (#003778).
