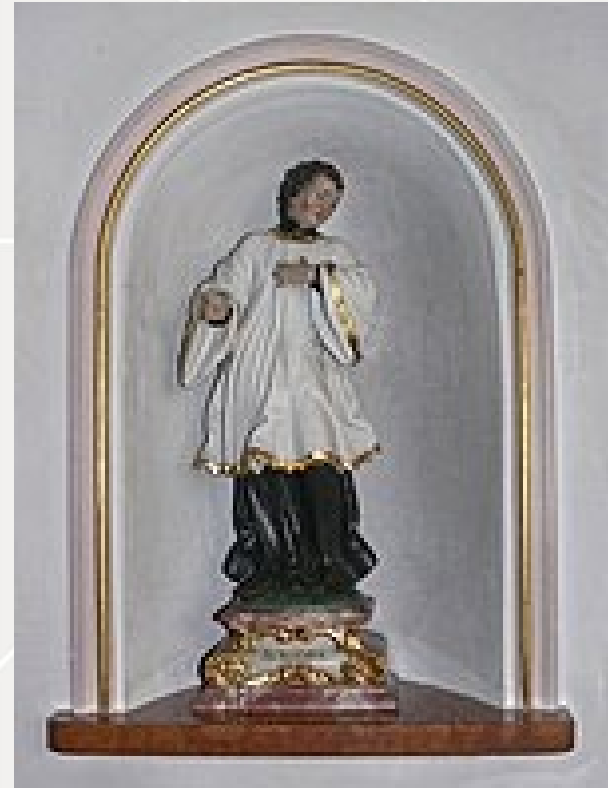

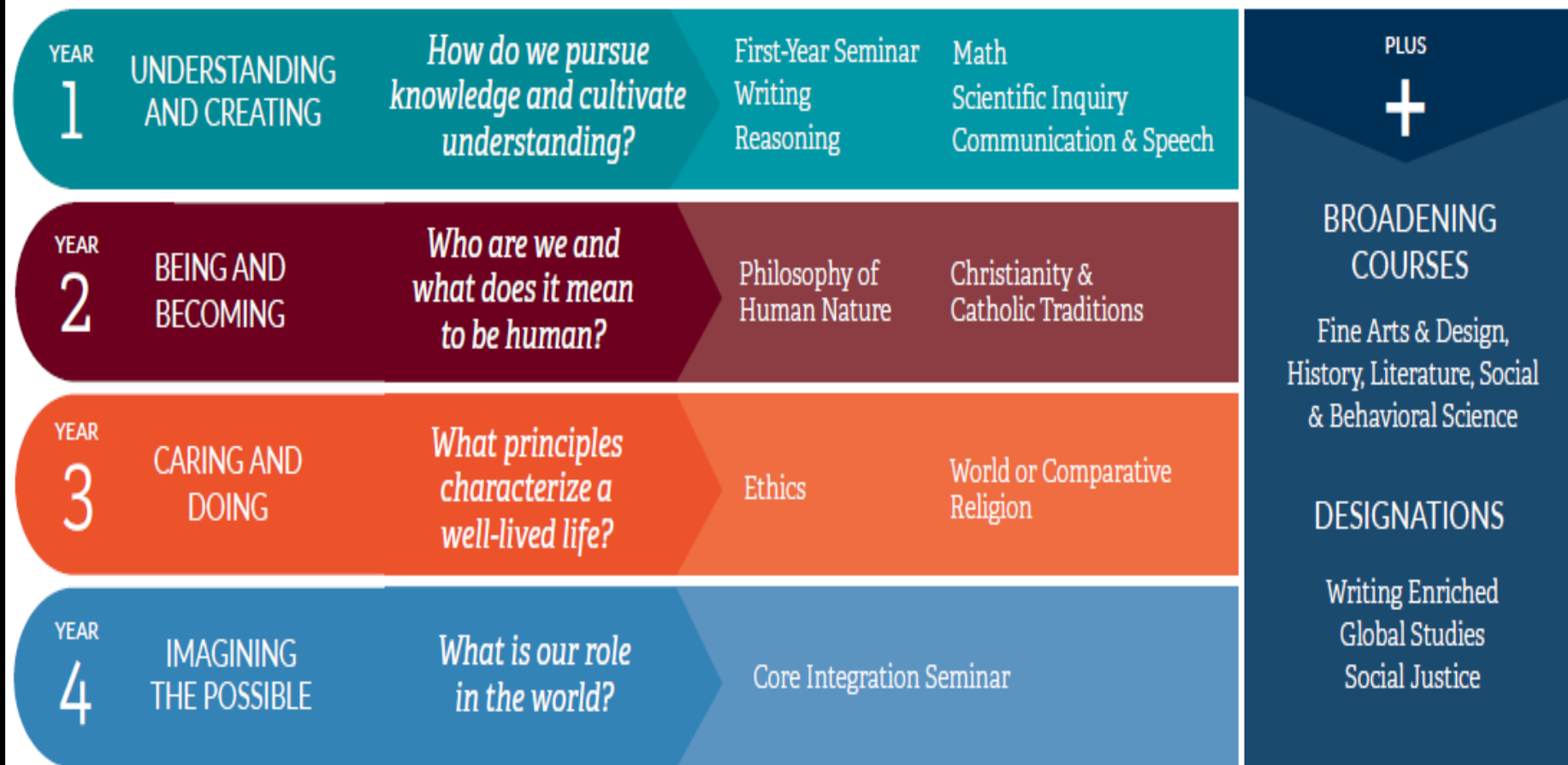

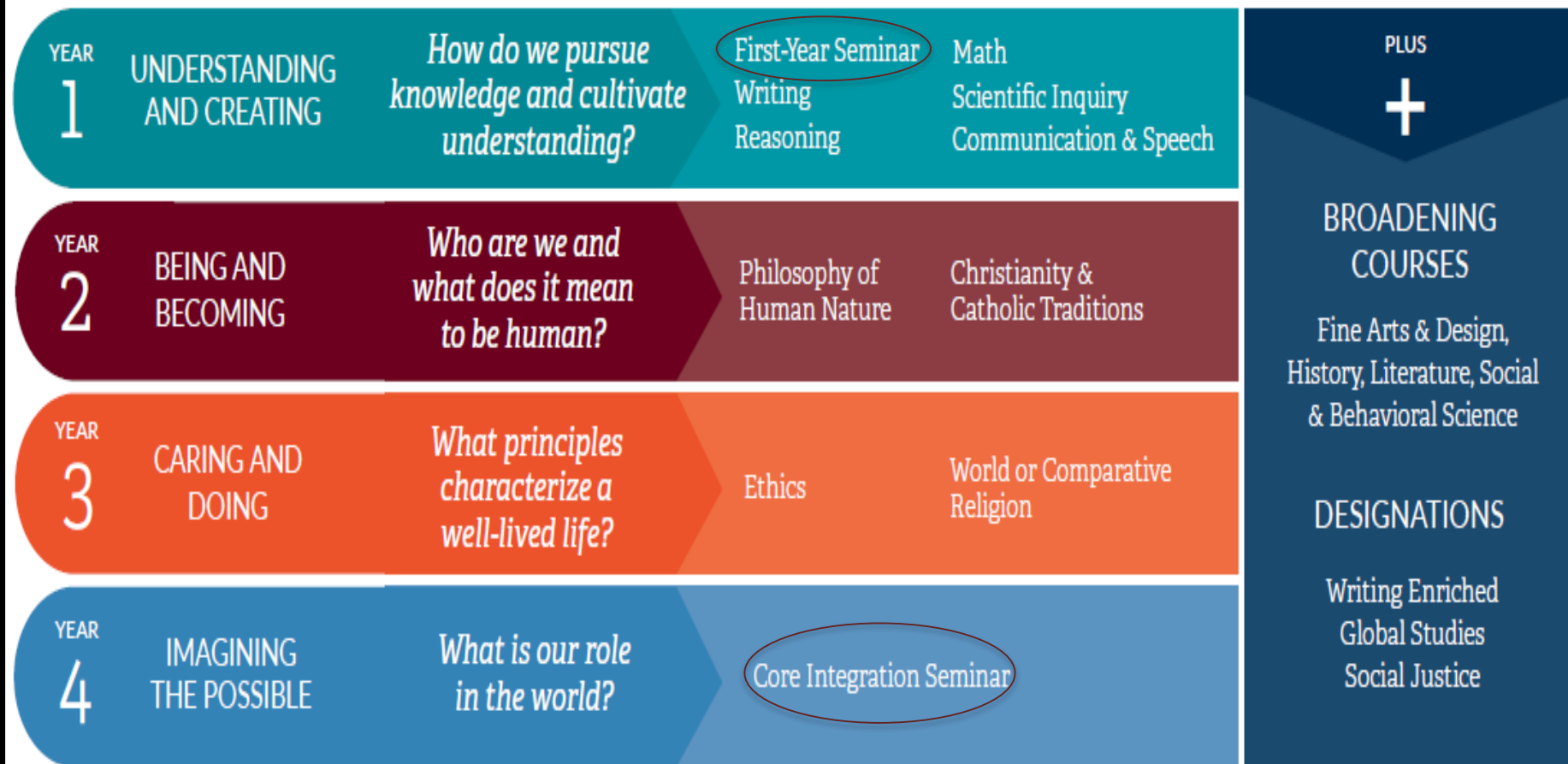

 - The Spirit of Finesse

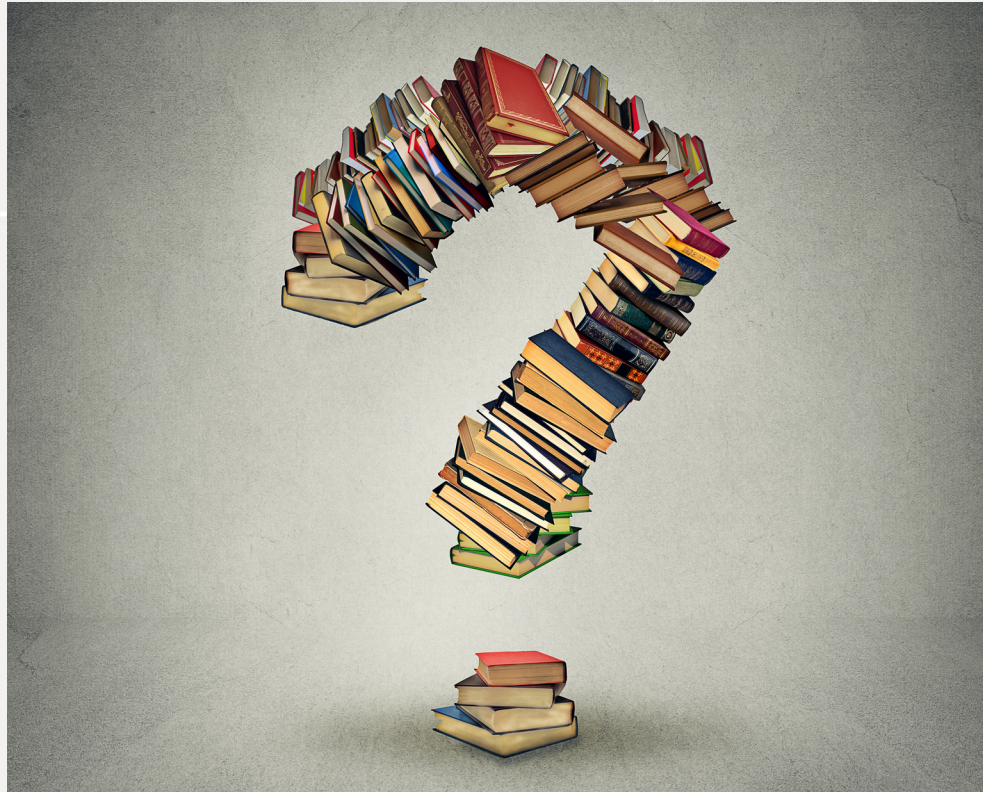


Gonzaga Graduates
