583 Students 9th-12th




75% of students indicated they want to learn more about climate change


80% of students indicated they want climate change education to take a <u>higher</u> priority in their classes




High school: Have you learned about the climate and/or climate change in any of your classes?



5th-8th: Have you learned about the climate and/or climate change in any of your classes?




Total: Have you learned about the climate and/or climate change in any of your classes?








### 5th-8th: Are you interested in learning more about climate?




Total: Are you interested in learning more about climate?
