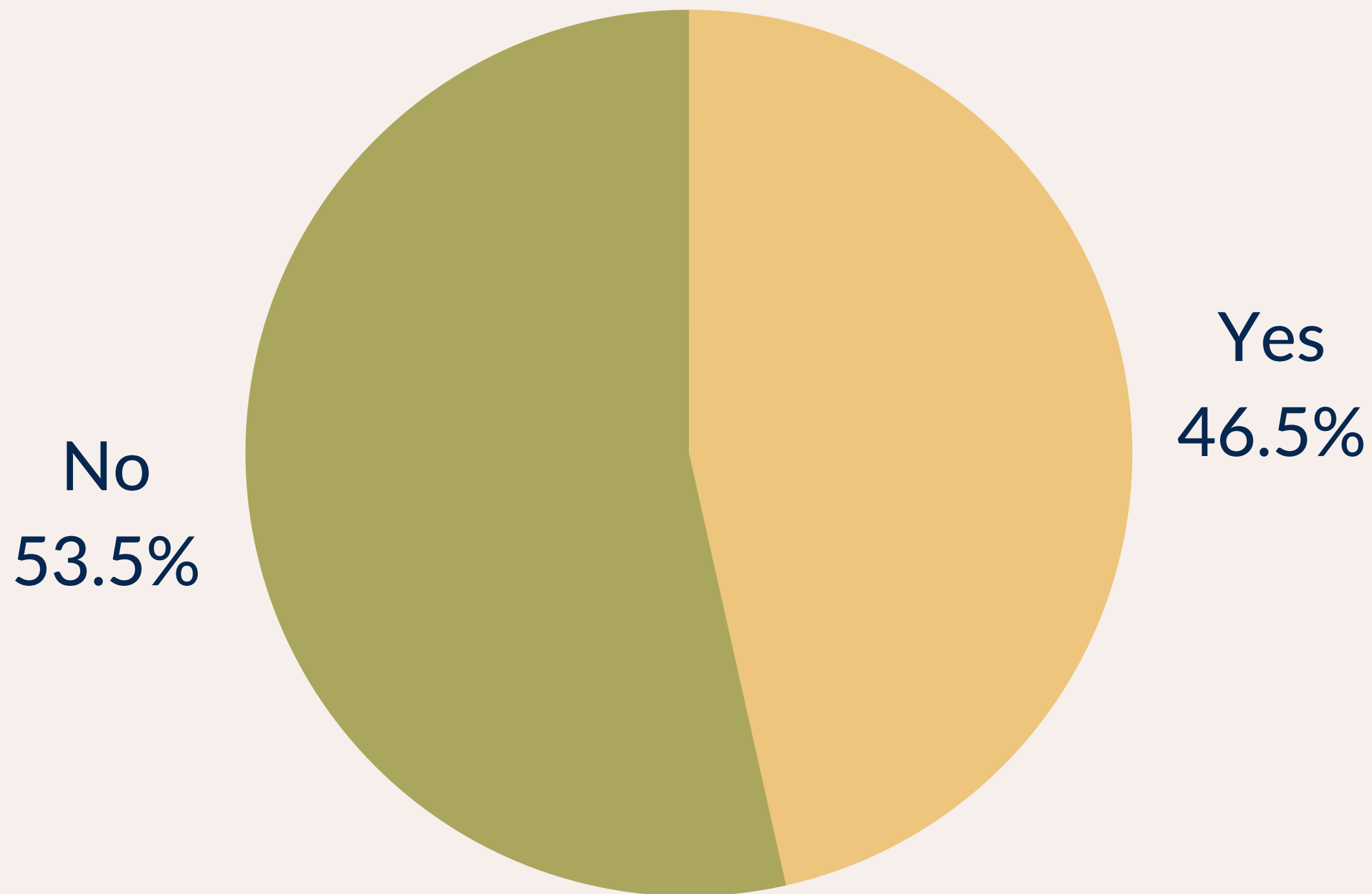
75% of students indicated they want to learn more about climate change

80% of students indicated they want climate change education to take a higher priority in their classes

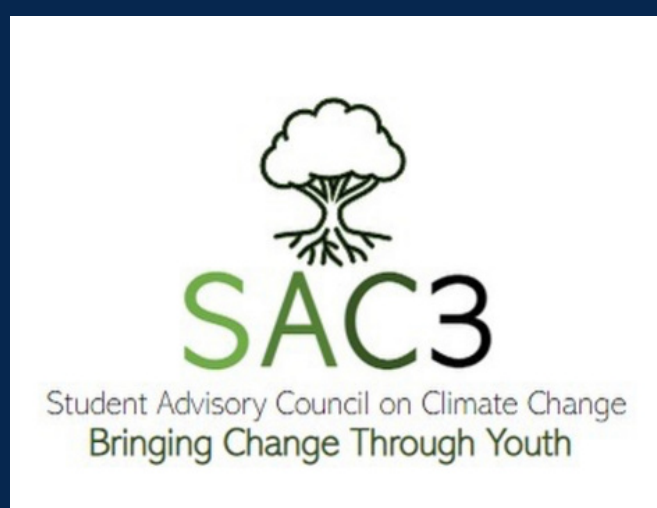
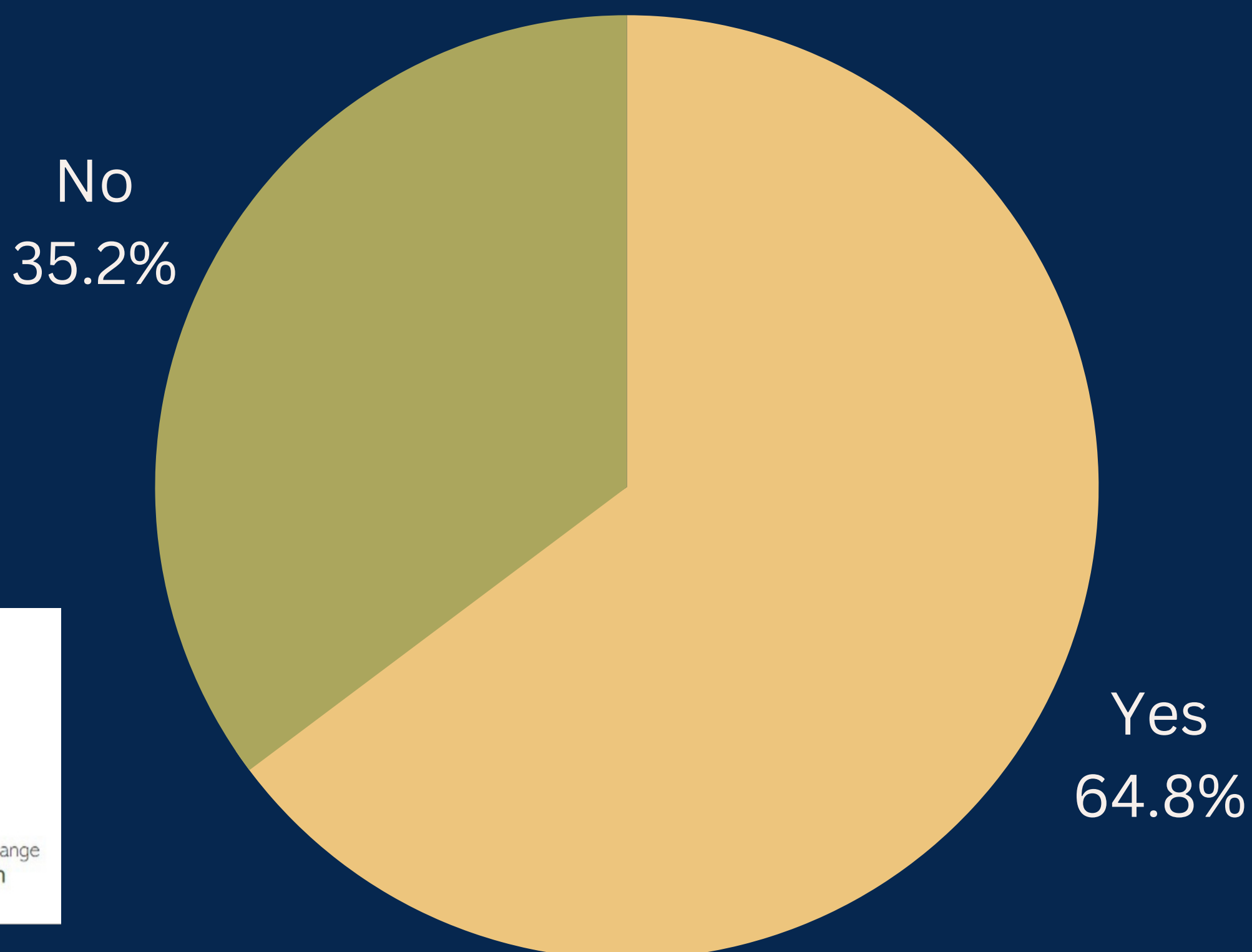

High school: Have you learned about the climate and/or climate change in any of your classes?



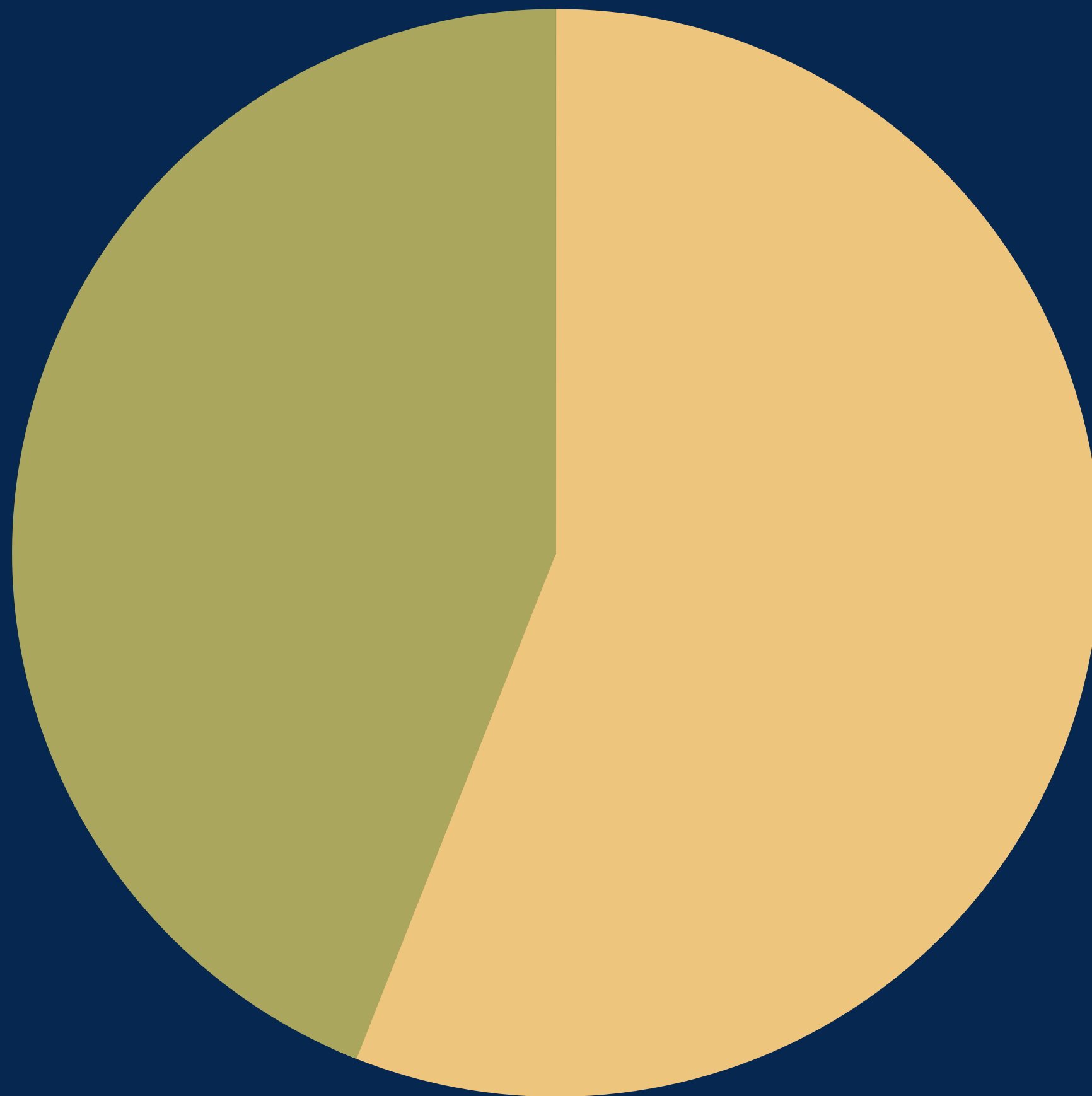
5th-8th : Have you learned about the climate and/or climate change in any of your classes?



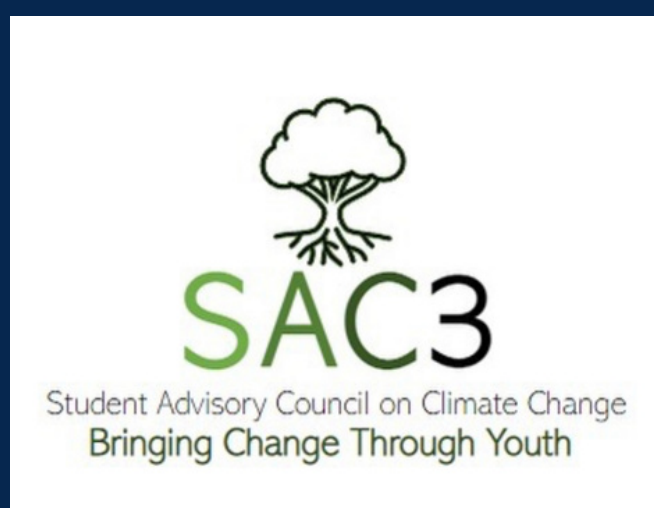

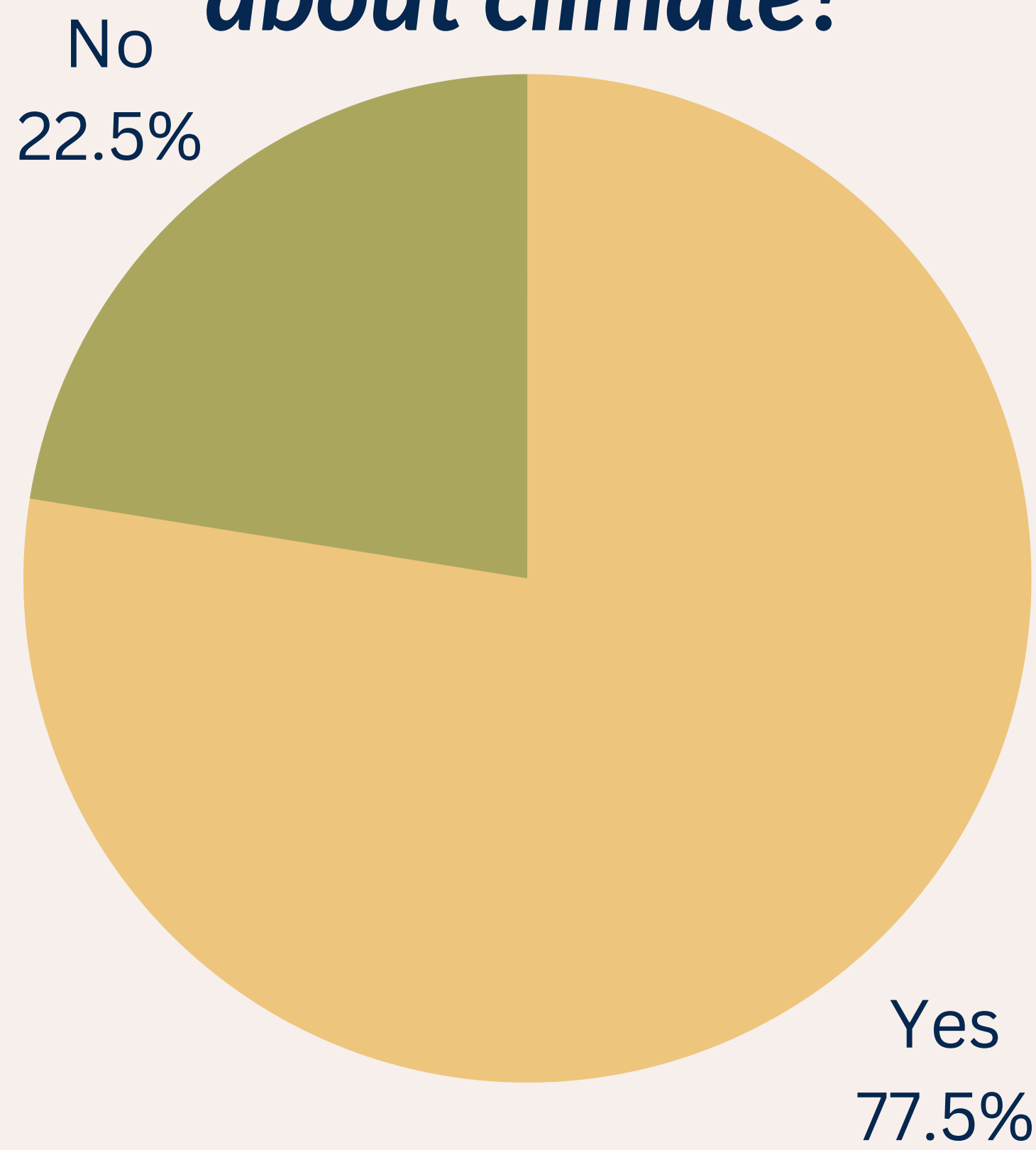

High school: Are you interested in learning more about climate?

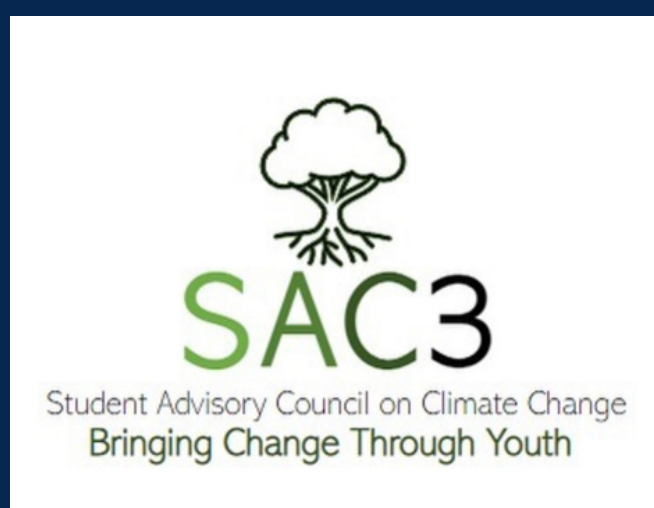
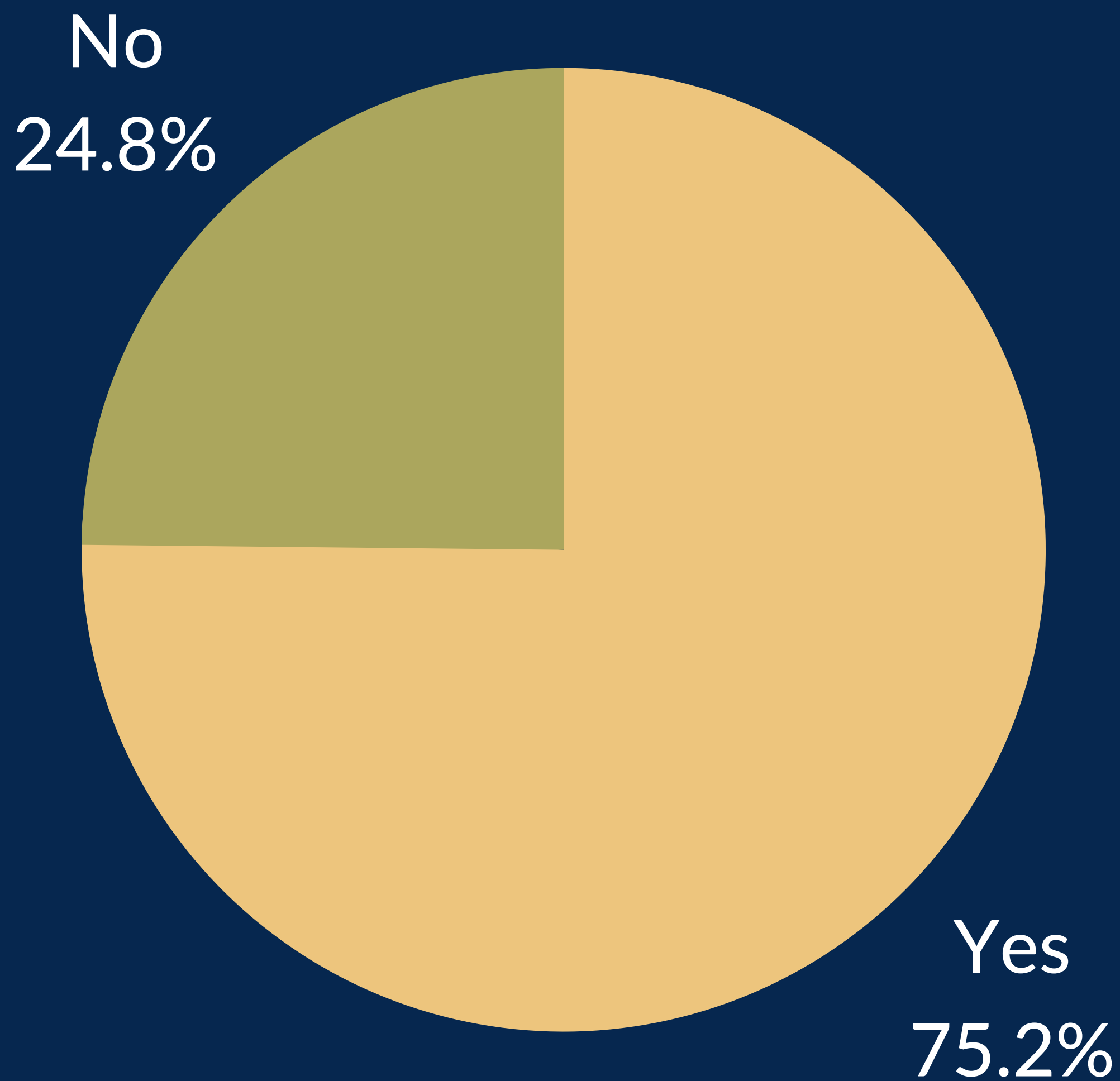


5th-8th: Are you interested in learning more about climate?



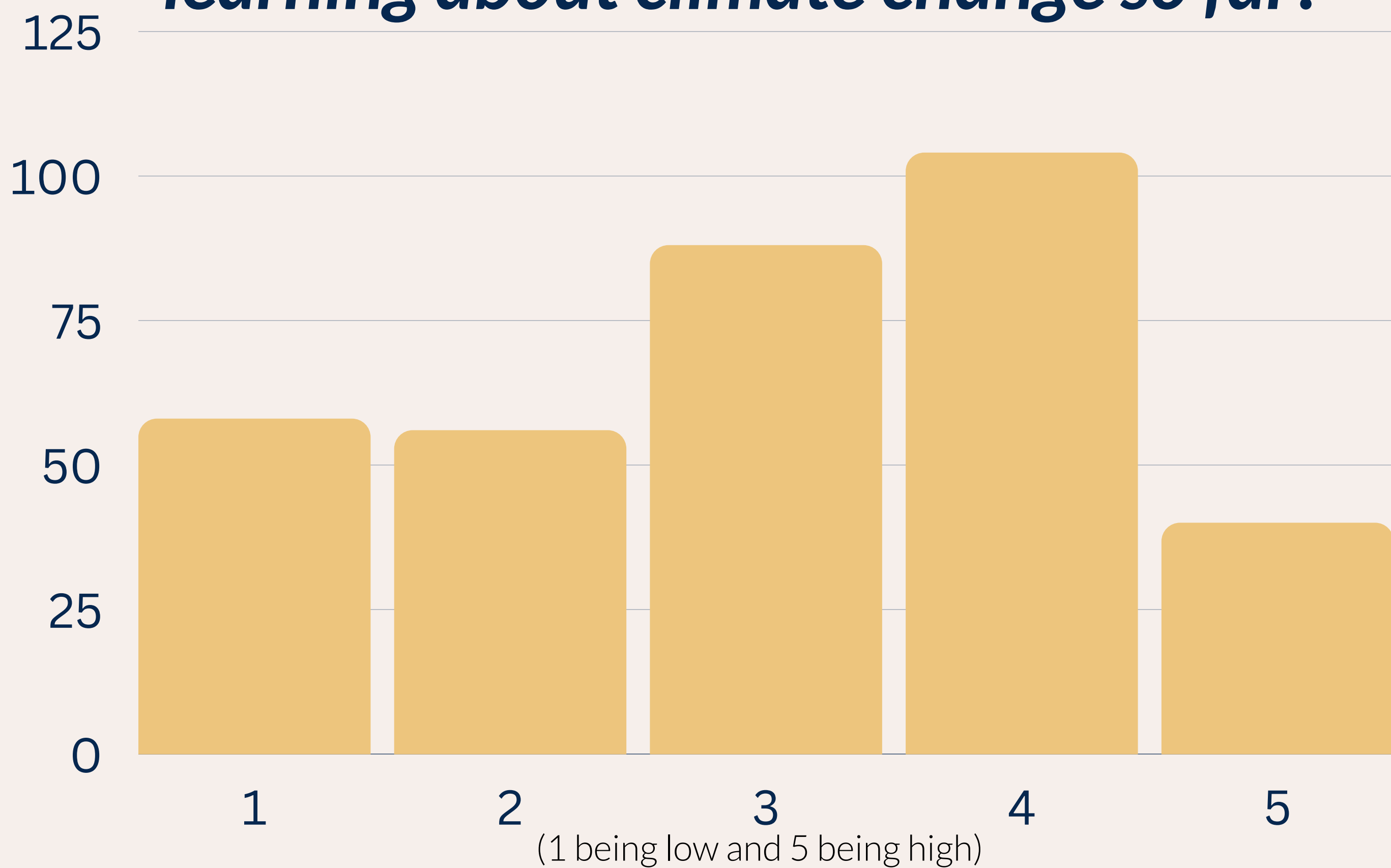
