### WHAT IS THE FUSE CAREER FAIR?

Previously known as the Partnership Fair, the FUSE Career Fair is an annual career fair held in downtown Spokane, Washington at the Convention Center. Each spring, Gonzaga University, Eastern Washington University, and Whitworth University host a collaborative career fair. Students from all of these Universities are invited to participate.

### PURPOSE

The 2022 Faculty Engagement Grant is designed to encourage faculty members from participating schools (Eastern Washington University, Gonzaga University, and Whitworth University) to integrate career-related networking skill development into the classroom experience by participating in the 2022 FUSE Career Fair.

### DESCRIPTION

The 2022 FUSE Career Fair is sponsoring a faculty engagement initiative. Faculty members can earn a \$500 professional development grant to be remitted to the faculty member's academic department and ear-marked for that faculty member's professional development.

### To be eligible, faculty members from the four Universities listed above must:

- 1) promote the 2022 FUSE Career Fair in their Spring 2022 courses,
- 2) attend the 2022 FUSE Career Fair with at least 30 of their students, and;
- 3) prepare a one-paged summary describing how they prepared students to participate in the 2022 FUSE Career Fair and how they followed-up with students after the event.

### PROCESS

- 1) Faculty member alerts career center staff members at each institution that they intend to participate in the initiative by Friday, April 1, 2022 by completing the Intent to Participate Form (the second page of this document).
- 2) Faculty member creates a PPT slide deck that explains how career fairs can enhance a job search and what to do at a career fair. Faculty members can contact their career center for assistance with this presentation if needed.
- 3) Faculty member attends the FUSE Career Fair and provides a roster of at least 30 students planning to attend the Fair.
- 4) Faculty provides the career center staff member with a 1-paged summary of what they did to prepare students, what they experienced at the fair, and how they followed up with students after the event.
